

Why participate?

- This survey helps assess our strengths, identify improvement areas, and guide strategy development across 7 key capacity areas to support student success.
- It will provide a score on the level of staff's understanding of how and why these areas are implemented and communicated.











What is this tool?

 A survey to facilitate capacity building in systemic institutional transformation to help SU move beyond an intervention-only focus.



Who needs to complete the Institutional Capacity Assessment Tool (ICAT) survey?

 All permanent staff members at SU are strongly encouraged to participate in this survey



Why should I complete this survey?

- SU gets a more holistic picture and greater insight into key capacity for student success;
- Engagement of stakeholders from all areas of the institution;
- Integrates and aligns student success efforts already begun;

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How does it work?

- You will receive an email with a link and Institutional access code.
- The survey will take approximately 60 minutes to complete.



Informed consent

Step 3:


- Answer by selecting from the list; then click continue.

Survey participants will have an open discussion with SU Management to:


- Share opinions and ideas;
