Social gradients, early childhood education and schools performing above expectation: empirical insights into educational issues

The candidate exploits a variety of data sets to consider selected education issues. She firstly applies a new methodology on within country educational inequality to compare seven African and sixteen Latin-American countries and finds that poor Ugandan and Mozambican children achieve much better educational outcomes than similarly poor South African children. The dissertation also investigates major impediments to expanding early childhood development programmes. Finally the author investigates the performance of poor schools which perform above demographic expectations and identifies only 5% of all poor schools that perform at an acceptable level. Poor learners who attend these schools gain up to a year of additional learning.

Financial frictions and macro-prudential policy in open economies

This dissertation studies topical issues on financial frictions and macro-prudential policy in open economies and consists of three articles. Paper one shows that permanent productivity shocks are more important in explaining business cycle fluctuations for a small open economy, such as South Africa. Financial frictions, such as country risk premium, play a significant role in explaining the fluctuations in investment and trade balance. Paper two develops a small open economy New Keynesian model with borrowing and lending constraints and show that introducing frictions like borrowing and lending constraints helps to explain the co-movement puzzle of durable and non-durable goods. Paper three investigates the welfare cost of macro-prudential policy and its impact on financial stability.

SWANEPOEL, Christie (Economics)

The private credit market of the Cape Colony, 1673–1834: wealth, property rights and social networks

A strong financial sector is important for economic development. In this dissertation, the candidate uses records of credit transactions in probate inventories to investigate the historical private credit market of the Cape Colony. She shows that it was the wealthy, not the poor, who borrowed most, and that such debt was used for investment purposes. Using network analysis, she finds evidence of strong family networks that persisted over the eighteenth century. This dissertation expands our understanding of the economic history of the VOC period, and showcases the benefits of econometric and statistical techniques when combined with large historical data sets.

vir sy internasionaal gerekende bydrae tot musiekwetenskap, vir sy baanbrekende navorsing oor Afrika se musiek, en vir sy rol om, as bewys van die akademieskap wat Afrika kan voortbring, 'n volgende geslag vakkundiges van die vasteland tot voorbeeld te strek.

As professor in musiekwetenskap en -teorie aan die Universiteit van Princeton, is prof Kofi Agawu, 'n boorling van Ghana, een van die mees gerekende musiekwetenskaplikes wat Afrika nog opgelewer het. Sy groot verskeidenheid publikasies oor die vasteland se musiek het die goudstandaard vir vakkundigheid op dié gebied geword en het daartoe bygedra dat Afrikamusiek deel van die hoofstroom van internasionale musieknavorsing geword het.

Agawu is bekend daarvoor dat hy in sy musieknavorsing vele tradisionele grense oorstee. Veral sy gelyktydige verkenning van die twee uiteenlopende musiektradisies van 18de- en 19de-eeuse Europa en van Wes-Afrika en sy geslaagde oorbrugging van wat voorheen as onversoenbare kulturele tradisies beskou is, word as 'n rigpunt vir alle soortgelyke navorsing beskou. Hy lewer ook baanbrekerbydraes tot semiotiek en postkoloniale studie. Sy indrukwekkende lys eerbewyse, waaronder die gesogte Dent-medalje van die *Royal Musical Association* en die *International Musicological Society* vir "uitstaande bydraes tot musiekwetenskap", getuig van die besondere agting waarmee die internasionale musiek- en akademiese wêreld hom bejeën.

Sy genootskap van die Ghanese Akademie van Kuns en Wetenskap en langdurige assosiasie met die Universiteit van Ghana wys egter sy verbintenis tot sy plaaslike wortels. Ook as pas aangestelde buitengewone professor in die Departement Musiek van die Universiteit Stellenbosch (US) sal sy kundigheid 'n aanwinst wees in die ontwikkeling van rigtinggewende perspektiewe vir 'n volgende geslag musiekkundiges.

Die US is trots daarop om met 'n wetenskaplike van prof Agawu se stuur verbind te word. Deur internasionale aansien met 'n verbintenis tot Afrika te verenig, is hierdie gesiene akademikus die beligaming van die soort vakkundiges wat die vasteland kan en moet oplewer.

for his internationally acclaimed contribution to musicology, for his ground-breaking research on African music, and for serving as an inspiration to a next generation of African scholars by epitomising the quality of scholarship that can emerge from this continent.

As professor of musicology and music theory at Princeton University, Prof Kofi Agawu, a Ghanaian by birth, is one of the most respected scholars of music to have come from Africa. His wide-ranging publications on the music of the continent have set the standard for scholarship in this field and have served to introduce African music into the mainstream of international music research.

Agawu is known for crossing numerous traditional boundaries in musical scholarship. Particularly his ability to straddle the two very different musical traditions of 18th and 19th-century Europe and of West Africa and to bridge the gap between what were up to then regarded as irreconcilable cultural differences is regarded as a benchmark for all similar research. He has also made ground-breaking contributions to semiotics and postcolonial studies. His impressive list of accolades, including the prestigious Dent medal awarded by the Royal Musical Association and the International Musicological Society in recognition of "outstanding contributions to musicology", attest to the respect he commands from the global academic and music world.

Yet, his fellowship of the Ghana Academy of Arts and Sciences and long-standing affiliation with the University of Ghana illustrate that he remains committed to his African roots. Also, as newly appointed extraordinary professor in the Department of Music at Stellenbosch University (SU), his expertise will be instrumental in developing perspectives that will point the way forward to a next generation of musicologists.

SU is proud to be associated with a scholar of Prof Agawu's stature. By combining an international reputation with a commitment to Africa this esteemed academic embodies the type of scholar that the continent can and must deliver.

Dr Monique Nsanzabaganwa het as Rwandese kabinetsminister tot die merkwaardige ekonomiese ommekeer in haar land bygedra en Afrika-vroue hulle ekonomiese stem help vind.

Ná twee ekonomiegrade van die Universiteit van Rwanda kom volg sy in 2000 die Universiteit Stellenbosch (US) se magisterprogram in ekonomie. Ondanks die taalhindernis gradueer sy as topstudent in 2002. Pas tuis, word dié briljante vakkundige op 32 minister van ekonomiese beplanning. Onverskrokke voor Nsanzabaganwa Rwanda se ekonomiese ontwikkeling- en armoedeverligtingstrategie en eerste regulasieraamwerk vir mikrofinansiering aan. Sy stig die hoog aangeskrewe Nasionale Instituut vir Statistiek. Hierná streef sy as minister van handel en nywerheid na 'n meer gebalanseerde Rwandese ekonomie: Sy help plaas Rwanda onder die 50 mees sakevriendelike ekonomieë wêreldwyd, en eerste in Afrika vir institusionele gehalte, en sorg vir volgehoue gemiddelde ekonomiese groei van 9%. Rwandese inflasie, ongelikheid en armoede daal.

Sy sit haar PhD-studie aan die US voort met 'n impakryke proefskrif oor privaatsektorsake ná die Rwandese menseslagting, en gradueer kort nadat sy aangestel is as adjunkpresident van die Rwandese Nasionale Bank, waar sy nou met finansiële regulering en monetêre beleid gemoeid is. As kampvegter vir vrouebemagtiging, ook op finansiesgebied, dien Nsanzabaganwa in die Afrika-adviesraad vir *Women's World Banking*. Sy lei ook me Graça Machel se *New Faces New Voices*, wat die vasteland se vroue groter finansiële invloed wil gee.

Deur vakkundigheid met sosiale impak te kombineer, waarna die US ook streef, het dr Monique Nsanzabaganwa op vroeë ouderdom 'n onuitwisbare invloed op haar land en vasteland gehad. Sy is lewende bewys van die krag van kennis.

to Monique Nsanzabaganwa,

for her role in developing academically sound economic policies for Rwanda, thereby improving her compatriots' quality of life, for her contribution in creating world-class state institutions, and for her activism to establish women as key players in the African economy.

Dr Monique Nsanzabaganwa was instrumental in the remarkable economic turnaround in Rwanda serving as a cabinet minister, and has helped African women find their economic voice.

Following two economics degrees from the University of Rwanda, she enrolled for the master's programme in economics at Stellenbosch University (SU) in 2000. Despite the language barrier, she graduated top of her class in 2002. Hardly had she returned home when this

brilliant scholar was appointed minister of economic planning at 32. Undaunted, Nsanzabaganwa initiated Rwanda's economic development and poverty alleviation strategy, and its first regulatory framework for microfinance. She also founded the highly regarded National Institute for Statistics. In her next ministerial portfolio, trade and industry, she campaigned for a more balanced Rwandese economy. She helped put Rwanda amongst the 50 most business-friendly economies globally, and first in Africa for institutional quality, and ensured 9% sustained average economic growth. Rwandese inflation, inequality and poverty declined.

She continued her PhD studies at SU with a high-impact dissertation on private-sector business in post-genocide Rwanda, and graduated shortly following her appointment as deputy governor of the Rwandese National Bank, where she is closely involved in financial regulation and monetary policy. As an advocate for women empowerment, including in the financial sector, Nsanzabaganwa serves in the Africa advisory board for Women's World Banking. She also heads up Ms Graça Machel's New Faces New Voices, which aims to expand the financial influence of the continent's women.

By combining scholarship with social impact, which SU also pursues, Dr Monique Nsanzabaganwa has left an indelible mark on her country and continent at a young age. She is living proof of the power of knowledge.
