4. Cell phone banking from Standard Bank banking services

To register dial *120*2345# from your cell phone and follow the easy steps to register. Once you have registered, open the cell phone banking application and proceed with the following steps:

Step 1: Press 6 for Bill Payments

- Step 2: Press I to make a payment
- Step 3: Select an account to pay from
- Step 4: Press 3 for the category service provider: Education
- Step 5: Select 0 for More
- Step 6: Select I- University of Stellenbosch
- Step 7: Enter the amount you want to pay
- Step 8: Enter our beneficiary reference: Student number
- Step 9: Confirm your payment details
