

PRE-REGISTRATION CLEARANCE (VERIFICATION) of INTERNATIONAL DEGREE-SEEKING STUDENTS DOCUMENTATION BEFORE ACADEMIC REGISTRATION 2023

1. <u>PRE-REGISTRATION CLEARANCE FOR ALL INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS STELLENBOSCH</u> CAMPUS: (UNDERGRADUATE & POSTGRADUATE)

- Before you can register for your academic programme of study, you must be cleared by SU International through a process known as pre-registration clearance/verification.
- <u>All</u> international students including permanent resident holders, refugees and asylum seeker status students are required to provide copies of supporting documentation for pre-registration clearance/verification prior to registering for the academic programme.
- Pre-Registration clearance will commence as from <u>Monday</u>, <u>9 January 2023</u> for all international students, including permanent resident holders, refugees and asylum seeker status students

3. COMPULSORY CERTIFIED DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED:

a) Study Visa & Lesotho Exemption Permit (LEP) Students [Residential in SA]

- Copy of valid passport
- Copy of valid study visa issued to study at Stellenbosch University / ZEP / LEP
- International students with Permanent residence in <u>ANY</u> country in Africa can upload proof of permanent residence in Africa [OPTIONAL]
- Proof that you have medical cover with a South African medical provider for the full year (Jan -Dec 2023)

- Proof of minimum <u>compulsory</u> initial fee payment or scholarship letter as per <u>2023 Compulsory</u>
 Fees <u>Document</u>

b) Permanent Resident Holders

- Students with permanent residence must upload a valid proof of permanent residence or non-SA ID document.
- Medical cover is not compulsory for permanent resident permit students.
- Pay as SA student as per 2023 Compulsory Fees Document

c) Refugee and Asylum Seeker Status students

- Students with refugee or asylum seeker status are exempt from the passport but must upload a copy of a valid refugee and/or asylum seeker permit.
- Medical cover is not compulsory for refugee and asylum seeker status students.
- Pay as SA student as per <u>2023 Compulsory Fees Document</u>

d) Diplomatic Status Students [Residential in SA]

- Copy of valid passport
- Copy of valid diplomatic status permit
- Medical cover is **not** compulsory for Diplomatic status students.
- Pay as SA student as per <u>2023 Compulsory Fees Document</u>

e) Postgraduate Students for Part-Time studies on a Work visa

International Postgraduate students enrolling for part-time studies, who are residential in SA during the 2023 academic year while completing their degree, need to upload:

- Copy of valid passport
- Copy of valid work visa
- Medical cover is not compulsory for students on a work visa
- Proof of minimum <u>compulsory</u> initial fee payment or scholarship letter as per <u>2023 Compulsory</u>
 Fees <u>Document</u>

f) Non-residential Postgraduate Students [Modular / Contact only]

- International postgraduate students who are registering for a non-residential/modular programme and who will not be residing in SA during the 2023 academic year while completing their degree, need to upload a copy of a valid passport.
- Medical cover is not compulsory for non-residential postgraduate students.
- Proof of minimum <u>compulsory</u> initial fee payment or scholarship letter as per <u>2023 Compulsory</u>
 <u>Fees Document</u>
