Duration	1 to 12 months
Scholarship	 KU Leuven students: 650 euros per month Incoming students to KU Leuven: 800 euros per month Travel allowance: between 320 and 1100 euros, depending on the distance Funding is limited to a maximum of 4 months. A longer stay abroad is allowed
	but without scholarship.
Documents	 The following documents must be submitted digitally and in English: The application form A learning agreement or training agreement (signed and approved by the student's faculty) Official transcripts of records (current and previous academic years) Personal and academic motivation letter (max 2 A4) Signed recommendation letter from a professor / lecturer Copy of international passport
Selection	The KU Leuven applies on behalf of both students who participate in the exchange. Institutions from Brazil, Chili, Japan, Morocco, Russia, South Africa, Mexico, Turkey and the USA shall cooperate fully in supplying precise information on applicants.
