INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE AGRICULTURAL PARTNERSHIP FOR YOUTH DEVELOPMENT STUDENT INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

The Western Cape Department of Agriculture (WCDoA) offers opportunities to **fifteen (15)** student interns requiring **Work Integrated Learning (WIL)** exposure in agriculture to obtain their qualifications.

Persons with a disability and females are encouraged to apply.

 The internship targets agriculture students who must undergo Work Integrated Learning/a Student Internship to complete their qualifications. Students must be South African, registered towards a recognised diploma/degree in agriculture from a college or university. The application must be accompanied by a letter from the institution of higher learning, indicating the required WIL period. Only applications from youth (18-35 years) will be considered. Applicants will be placed with external host employers. 	Successful applicants will be appointed on a fixed-term contract for 12 to 18 months, depending on their higher institution of learning requirements.
