
FACULTY-SPECIFIC E-MAIL TO UNDERGRADUATE EMS STUDENTS DATED 9 JUNE 2020:



Dear Undergraduate EMS Students

I hope that you are well and that you are ready and well prepared for the assessment time. At this time I want to communicate the following important points (again), further to my previous email.

1. MARKS ON SUNLEARN:

- After A2: Students will see their raw mark for A2 and the calculated mark (as per the formula)
 on SUNLearn.
- All students will see "further assessment allowed" on MyMaties after A2 (even if you have passed). The reason for this is to communicate that you can use A3 if you choose to do so, as the best of A2 or A3 will be used to calculate your final mark.
- Your final mark will be uploaded on MyMaties AFTER A3 only.

2. 30 MINUTES UPLOAD TIME:

- The Senate decision stands as I have communicated it to you previously. If you miss the upload time, irrespective of the reason, you will have to make use of the next assessment opportunity. The lecturer is not involved in the upload process at all and they cannot make decisions that allows for late submissions. The same principles applied in face to face assessments if you miss the assessment, you have to use the next assessment opportunity. I acknowledge that this is a hard rule, but necessary.
- PLEASE do not use the upload time to write as you will add to your stress levels and incur the risk of not being able to upload in time.
