- To qualify for the DCE, please note that you need to be registered as a final-year undergraduate student.
- Final-year students from other faculties following EMS modules, have to verify DCE rules applicable to their specific faculties.

### Within the **FACULTY OF ECONOMIC AND MANAGEMENT SCIENCES** the following rules apply to the Dean's Concession Examination (DCE):

- A Dean's Concession Exam may be granted in a module if it is the only module that the final-year student needs to graduate and only if a final mark of at least 30 has been achieved in the relevant module.
- For 2021 there will be **no** DCE opportunities for first semester and year modules, given the extraordinary concession for Assessment 4 (A4) rounds, scheduled to be written in January 2021.
- Students registered for programmes within the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences have to follow the Dean's Concession Exam guidelines applicable within that faculty.
- All DCEs will be written during a single examination sitting by the end of February before the commencement of lectures, and no further examination papers will be set for this purpose.
- Verify your academic results after the November assessments and, should you qualify, remember to register a.s.a.p. for the DCE.
- If you think you will possibly qualify for the DCE, register electronically for the DCE via the DCE registration link (on the faculty website at [www.sun.ac.za/ems](http://www.sun.ac.za/ems)) **by 29 January 2021. The results of A4 will only be available on 12 February 2021.**
- **Please note:** Even if you have met the requirements to write the Dean's Concession Exam (DCE), **you have to register.** If you do not follow the registration procedure, we will not be able to effectively prepare for the Dean's Concession exam.

## EBW Dekaaansvergunningeksamen (DVE): Riglyne

- Ten einde vir die DVE te kwalifiseer, moet jy as 'n voorgraadse finalejaarstudent geregistreer wees.
- Ander fakulteite se finalejaarstudente wat EBW-modules volg, moet die DVE-riglyne nagaan wat van toepassing is in hulle spesifieke fakulteite.

### In die FAKULTEIT EKONOMIESE EN BESTUURSWETENSKAPPE geld die volgende reëls vir die Dekaaansvergunningeksamen (DVE):

- 'n Dekaaansvergunningeksamen kan vir een enkele module toegestaan word, slegs indien dit die enigste module is wat die finalejaarstudent kort om te gradueer én mits 'n finale punt van minstens 30 in die betrokke module verwerf is.
- Vir 2021 sal daar **geen** DVE vir eerstesemester-modules en jaarmodules wees nie, gegewe die Assessering 4-rondte (A4) wat as ekstra vergunning in Januarie 2021 geskryf gaan word.
- Studente wat vir programme in die Fakulteit Lettere geregistreer is, moet egter die reëls van die Dekaaansvergunningeksamen (DVE) van daardie fakulteit volg.
- Alle Dekaaansvergunningeksamens word tydens 'n enkele eksamengeleentheid vóór die aanvang van voorlesings teen einde Februarie afgelê en geen verdere eksamenvraestelle sal vir die doel van 'n Dekaaansvergunningeksamen opgestel word nie.
- Kontroleer jou uitslae na afloop van die November-assesserings en, indien jy wel kwalifiseer, onthou asseblief om so gou moontlik vir die DVE vir tweedesemester-modules te registreer.
- Indien jy meen dat jy moontlik vir die DVE kwalifiseer, registreer elektronies daarvoor via die DVE-registrasieskakel (op die fakulteitswebwerf by [www.sun.ac.za/ebw](http://www.sun.ac.za/ebw)) **teen 29 Januarie 2021. Die uitslae van A4 is eers op 12 Februarie 2021 beskikbaar.**
- **Let wel:** Selfs al voldoen jy aan die vereistes vir die Dekaaansvergunningeksamen (DVE), **móét jy daarvoor registreer.** Indien jy nie die registrasieprosedure volg nie, sal ons nie doeltreffende voorbereidings vir die aflegging van die DVE kan tref nie.
