## 01

The Faculty of Economic and Management Sciences, a strategic educational component within Stellenbosch University, is unequivocally committed to **redressing the injustices** of the past.



This charter is grounded in the tenets of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa and supports SU's **transformation goals** as articulated in SU Vision 2040.

## 03

We individually and collectively pledge to **eliminate systemic and individual discrimination** on the basis of race, sex, gender identity, age, disability, religion, language, culture, socio-economic status or hierarchy. **Compassion**: recognition of and care for, the wellbeing of all our students and staff (SU Transformation Plan)

Accountability: accepting the highest level of responsibility for our actions (SU Transformation Plan)

**Equity**: restitution in response to our past legacy, and fairness in our aspirations (SU Transformation Plan) We are guided by the principle of mutual respect and the values of accountability, compassion, equity, equality, redress and social justice **Equality**: "the full and equal enjoyment of rights and freedoms as contemplated in the Constitution" (Promotion of Equality and Prevention of Unfair Discrimination Act), which in an unequal society, can only be achieved through equity



**Social justice**: the equal enjoyment of all rights and freedoms regardless of human diversity reflected in the fair and just distribution of all opportunities, benefits, privileges and burdens in a society or group (Centre for Social Justice, SU)



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
