Language of tuition

There are separate class groups for Afrikaans and English

Admission requirements for students who completed their undergraduate studies at Stellenbosch University:

60% weighted average for four professional subjects

Financial Accounting 379 (4)
Management Accounting 378 (4)
Taxation 399 (3)
Auditing 378 (3)

(Weightings used in the calculation of the weighted average are shown in brackets)

OR

55% weighted average for the four professional subjects (The same weightings shown above are used in the calculation of the weighted average)

AND

55% for Financial Accounting 379

All the subjects need **not** be passed in one year, but subjects must be passed within 2 years before the start of the BAccHons program that is being applied for

For 2019: earliest = 2016 For 2020: earliest = 2017 Students registered as <u>special students</u> to bridge from BCom(Management Accounting) or BCom(Financial Accounting) in order to apply for admission to BAccHons in 2019, may present **Management Accounting 388** instead of Management Accounting 378 for selection purposes if the former was passed with a minimum performance mark of 60%. The two year rule referred to above also applies in this case.

Percentages are based on performance marks as they appear on the university's central systems.

Deans concession examinations may only be written by students officially qualifying for it. Students who complete the examination successfully, will be considered for BAccHons admission. A performance mark of 50% will be used for admission purposes in respect of that subject.

Maximum performance mark that can be awarded to students who wrote **both** the first and second examinations is <u>50%</u>. This rule is not applicable to students who choose to write the second examination instead of the first examination.

Admission requirements are minimum requirements.

There is no additional admission opportunity.

Admission requirements for students who completed their undergraduate studies at universities other than Stellenbosch University:

Admission requirements for students who completed their undergraduate studies at universities other than Stellenbosch University are available on request from the School of Accountancy.

Requirement in respect of Company Law

<u>All</u> students (including those registered as <u>special students</u> to bridge from BCom(Management Accounting) or BCom(Financial Accounting) in order to apply for admission to BAccHons), should take note of the following:

Students who have not yet passed a Mercantile Law module in which the 'new' 2008 Companies Act was covered <u>in detail</u>, must register for and pass Mercantile Law 292 in order to be eligible for admission to BAccHons.

Mercantile Law 284 is not sufficient.
