## Apply for the Thuthuka Bursary Fund at Stellenbosch University today!

## Online application process

Thuthuka Bursary Fund (TBF) covers tuition, textbooks and residence fees (incl. food)

In order to qualify for the Stellenbosch University Thuthuka Bursary Fund(SUTBF) programme, you must meet the following requirements:

- you must apply to the TBF and submit all the required documentation as per these instructions;
- you need to meet the requirements of TBF before you can be considered by the Stellenbosch University project management team;
- you have to apply and be accepted to study the B.Accounting degree at Stellenbosch University (therefore you must meet the minimum requirements and apply in time at <https://web-apps.sun.ac.za/eAansoek2/alg.jsp?TI=1> )
- you have to apply for accommodation in residence on campus (it is a requirement of the bursary for you to stay in residence on campus);
- you have to take Accounting at school level and have a mark above 70%;
- you have to take Mathematics at school level and have a mark above 80%;
- you must write all 3 NBT tests;
- all three of your NBT test results must be above 45.

**Meeting the above minimum requirements is not a guarantee that the bursary will be awarded to you. The applicants will be ranked according to their matric results and applicants will be offered the bursary in order of this ranking list.**

The closing date for residence applications at Stellenbosch University is 30 June 2018.

**Before you start your TBF application you must have these documents and information ready to upload when you log on:**

- Copy of your Green ID Book or SA ID Card
- Copy of your Grade 11 Results
- Copy of your Grade 12 Results (if/when available)
- A signed consent form (available on the link)
- Your parents'/guardians' ID copy
- Your parents'/guardians' latest salary advice
- Copies of ID or Birth Certificates of other school-going dependants in your home
