SDG4: Quality Education

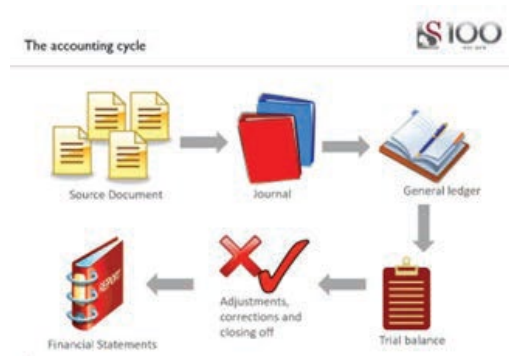

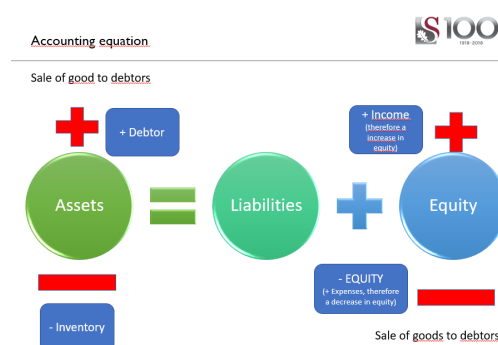
