

## Introduction

The domination of road transport coupled with the lack of viable alternatives in South Africa is the cause of the underutilisation of intermodal logistics in this country. Road transport domination is starting to raise environmental concerns due to the level of emissions that trucks emit as well as high freight logistics costs.
