She served on the Financial and Fiscal Commission for a decade as a Commissioner until 2014, and chaired its Research Committee. She has been a Senior Advisor at the Government Technical Advisory Centre (GTAC) in the National Treasury and a member of the Davis Tax Review Committee. She was appointed to the President’s Economic Advisory Council in 2019.
