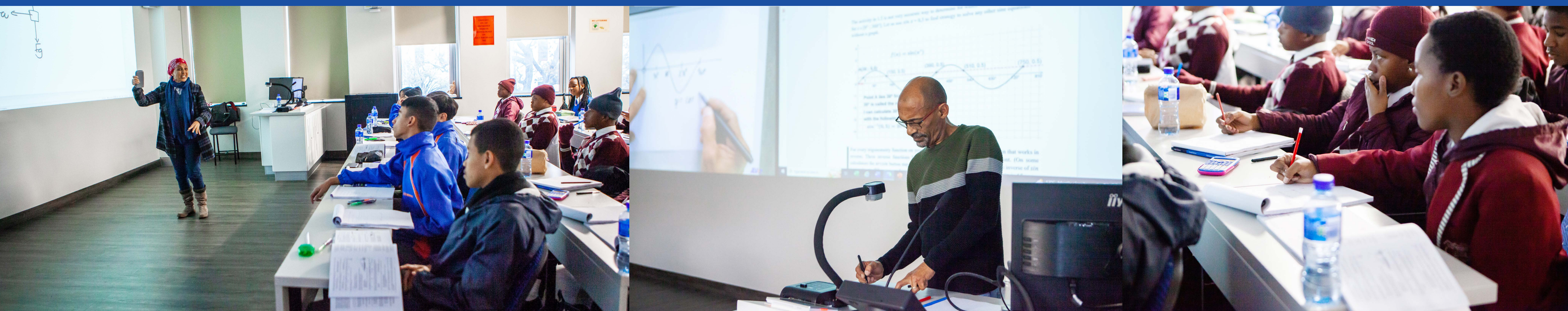

## Programme Information

The Stellenbosch Hub, an initiative of Stellenbosch University's Centre for Pedagogy (SUNCEP), is a pioneering educational support program designed to enhance the academic success of 25 carefully selected Grade 12 learners from the Stellenbosch region.

Focused on improving subject proficiency and fostering a passion for further education, the program offers face-to-face tuition, advanced teaching methods, and innovative technology.

The Hub's activities include five Saturday workshops and 3 one-week holiday camps, held at the Faculty of Education, where learners receive personalized instruction from academic specialists.

The program emphasizes a practice-based approach, allowing students to engage deeply with challenging content in Mathematics and Physical Sciences. SUNCEP's initiative also provides virtual classes and access to mobile data and a dedicated online learning platform to support students in preparing for their final examinations.

The Stellenbosch Hub represents a significant investment in the future of its participants, aiming to bridge educational gaps and equip them with the skills necessary for higher education and lifelong learning. By integrating traditional and modern teaching techniques, the Hub empowers students to improve their academic performance, thereby increasing their prospects for success in higher education and future careers.
