Load shedding procedures

The diesel generator currently providing electricity to the faculty when necessary, is only a temporary solution provided to 27 buildings across campus. The University is currently looking into more permanent and cost effective solutions.

Currently Facilities Management sends an operative to each generator before every scheduled load shedding during working hours (08:00 – 16:30).

The Dagbestuur proposes the following procedures to be followed if definite electricity supply is needed after 16:30:

- A person nominated by each department sends an e-mail before 10:00 to Janice Ghalpie (<u>ilp@sun.ac.za</u>) which indicates when electricity will be needed that evening and why (e.g. BEd II test 17:00 19:30 or BEd Hons class 19:30 21:00)
- Janice will inform Facilities Management of the faculty's electricity needs for the evening / weekend.
