Infectious Disease Epidemiology – Short course

Semester 2 - 2020

The Division of Epidemiology and Biostatistics, Department of Global Health, Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences, Stellenbosch University, will be offering a short course on Infectious Disease Epidemiology from July – November 2020.

Due to COVID-19, the short course will be exclusively online, using a combination of live syncronous webinars and online recordings. All teaching and learning will be faciliated via SunOnline. Online content will be spread over a period of weeks, with students required to engage with content weekly, punctuated with online discussion and webinars. There will be no face-to-face contact sessions for the module. The course is equivalent to the Infectious Disease Epidemiology module in the <u>MSc Clinical Epidemiology</u>

The focus of this short course is to introduce the principles and dynamics of control of infectious diseases in developing countries.

Content

- Introduction to Infectious diseases epidemiology
- Infectious diseases transmission dynamics
- Introduction to control of infectious diseases.
- Measuring vaccine efficacy
- Outbreak investigation
- Infectious diseases modelling
- Infectious diseases surveillance

Applicants need to have completed introductory courses of epidemiology and biostatistics.
