

## Master of Philosophy in Family Medicine



## M PHIL IN FAMILY MEDICINE



The M Phil Degree programme serves as a non-clinical Masters qualification. It is aimed at doctors who have an interest in the development of the discipline of Family Medicine, particularly its research base in Sub-Saharan Africa. It is intended for clinicians who may be interested in supervising, teaching, coordinating academic teaching, and conducting research in Family Medicine and Primary Care. It is not for those wanting to train clinically as family physician.

Applicants must be currently registered as an independent medical practitioner in the country where they are practising. The application process includes submission of a brief description of a proposed research topic.

In order to fulfill the requirements of the programme, the candidate must be working in a context suitable for the practice of Family Medicine or Primary Care.

The M Phil in Family Medicine is a 2-year programme. The academic modules are distance learning apart from the obligatory contact session in January, 1st year of studies, that will be held at the University (Tygerberg Campus).
