



Equality Unit	 The Equality Unit takes its inspiration from the South African Bill of Rights, where no person should be unfairly discriminated. The core function of the Unit is to assist students and staff who have been victimised, sexually harassed, unfairly discriminated, and who have been victims of gender-based violence through formal (and informal) complaint procedures. The EqU focuses on HIV, the LGBTQIA+ community, gender identity and sexualities. The Equality Unit has two dedicated Unfair Discrimination and Harassment Case Officers, a Case Investigations Support Officer, and a dedicated Gender Non-Violence Coordinator, who provides support services including coordination, monitoring, shared responsibility management, student movement support, training and providing an institutional response to GBV.
