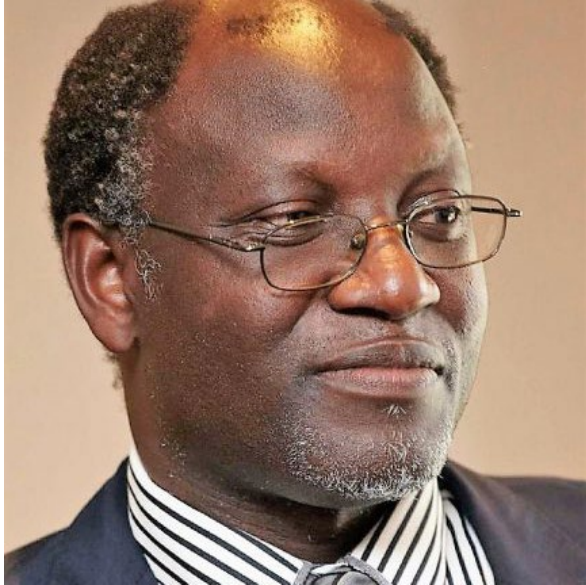


Prof Peter Nyasulu
