## ELS BACKGROUND

SU embarked on an ambitious and complex ELS project in November 2020, when, the University requested that students return to campus from the start of the 2021 academic year. Due to Covid-19 restrictions, lecture halls could only be used at a reduced capacity. With many students, therefore, attending the lectures remotely, the project aims to equip all schedulable lecture venues with audio-visual equipment and systems to enable lecturers to stream whilst teaching in a lecture hall. Lecturers can also interact with students who are not physically in the venues, thereby providing an interactive learning experience comparable to the in-class experience.
