

Master's in Nursing (MNurs)

Structured Masters Degree (two-year)

- Admission requirements:
A basic degree in nursing or equivalent or a postgraduate diploma in nursing.

Research Masters Degree (one year)

- Completion of a thesis
- Admission requirements:
Honours degree in nursing or equivalent.

Doctorate in Philosophy (PHD Nursing)

The student undertakes original research in the field of Nursing Science under supervision of a promoter as decided upon by the senate of the University.

A dissertation is to be completed and submitted for internal and external examination.

Admission requirements:

Masters degree in Nursing or equivalent.

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

