



Clinical Research Protocol Writing Course 12 April – 28 July 2021




TARGET AUDIENCE: Registrars and other (novice) researchers who are ready to begin or are in the process of drafting a quantitative or qualitative clinical research protocol. We also welcome consultants and supervisors who need a research refresher.

FORMAT: This is a blended course, facilitated both online and in-person, which consists of 5 online, self-study modules \square and 5 interactive contact sessions \square .

CONTENT: The course covers the basics of clinical research, and participants can choose to focus on quantitative or qualitative research methods. We also provide guidance on how to write a protocol and put together the associated documentation. We will not cover laboratory research or systematic reviews.

COURSE MAP: The course content **opens on 12 April** for pre-course reading and orientation, facilitated online. Module 1 opens on the same day as the first contact session, 21 April. After the second contact session, participants can choose to follow the quantitative OR qualitative modules and contact sessions.
