SIGLA and the RDDC are partnering to revisit the ongoing debate on ungoverned spaces as a source of threats, vulnerabilities and catalysts for extremism and terrorism. Using the notion of weak or absent governance as catalyst for extremism, radicalisation, terrorism and criminality, the conference programme covers topics and mechanisms on good governance as an early and preventative pathway for vulnerable governments to avoid costly military based counter-strategies on land, at sea and in the cyber domain. The geographic focus is on Africa and planned for two days of discussions by invited speakers in Stellenbosch, South Africa. The conference output is in the form of two policy papers within two weeks of the event and a book publication after a period of fourteen months.
