Security Governance in Africa's Ungoverned Spaces

Emergent Thought, New Spaces and Responses

SIGLA and the RDDC are partnering to revisit the ongoing debate on ungoverned spaces as a source of threats, vulnerabilities and catalysts for extremism and terrorism. Using the notion of weak or absent governance as catalyst for extremism, radicalisation, terrorism and criminality, the conference programme covers topics and mechanisms on good governance as an early and preventative pathway for vulnerable governments to avoid costly military based counter-strategies on land, at sea and in the cyber domain. The focus is on Africa with two mornings of vibrant discussions led by expert speakers.
