Research on Congregations

Ekklesia engages in rigorous practical theological research to equip Christians and the Church to effective engage in the work of renewal and transformation in society. The South African Partnership for Missional Churches, an Annual Research Conference, the Stellenbosch Winter School for congregational leaders and various tools, programmes and publications are produced as result.

MTh in Practical Theology and Post Graduate Diploma

(With focus on spiritual formation and missional Leadership)

Ekklesia, in association with the Department of Practical Theology, offers an MTh-degree as well as a Post Graduate Diploma, with a strong focus on discerning leadership or missionale spirituality in congregations. The facilitators in these courses are all leading academics and practitioners in their fields. In order to complete the MTh the students will need to complete 6 modules over two years as well as an extended research essay. Completion of the Post Graduate Diploma allows access to the MTh for persons who don't have sufficient previous theological training. Themes such as missional theology, leadership (in association with Stellenbosch Business School), Christian Spirituality and building Kingdom Communities are covered.

Church Planting: fresh Expressions South Africa
