

About the Bonhoeffer Congress, Stellenbosch, South Africa (19-23 January 2020)

You are cordially invited to the XIII. International Bonhoeffer Congress that will be held from *January 19th -23rd, 2020 in Stellenbosch, South Africa.*

The theme of the conference is: *How is the coming generation to go on living? Bonhoeffer and the response to our present crisis and hope.*

The congress will be hosted by the Faculty of Theology and the Beyers Naudé Center for Public Theology at Stellenbosch University, in partnership with the Department of Religion and Theology at the University of the Western Cape.
