The Higher Education Resource Services South Africa (HERS-SA) will once again host its annual ACADEMY for Women Leaders in Higher Education at the Double Tree by Hilton Hotel, Upper East Side, Woodstock, Cape Town from Sunday, 5th September to Thursday, 9th September 2021. The ACADEMY will also be offered online to accommodate those with comorbidities and Covid 19 related concerns.

HERS-SA was founded in 2003 to address the critical shortage of women in senior positions in Higher Education, a major area of concern within the sector. The HERS-SA ACADEMY offers a unique opportunity to women to shape their learning according to their development needs by selecting to participate in a range of plenary sessions, development workshops, breakaway activities and attending talks by well-known leaders within the Higher Education sector from our set programme. Our breakfast, lunch and evening dinners offer further informal networking opportunities.

#### **APPLICATION PROCESS AND FEES**

The fee for the 2021 ACADEMY is R20 000 (in-person) and R18 000 (online) inclusive of 15% VAT. The in-person fee INCLUDES all ACADEMY costs, materials, refreshments, lunches and official programme dinners. The online cost includes online hosting platform and support by an events hosting organisation, but excludes catering cost.

The **fee EXCLUDES delegate travel and accommodation costs** (on a bed & breakfast basis for which delegates are responsible), dinner on Tuesday evening, and daily parking costs at the hotel (i.e. day conference parking @ R60 overnight guest parking).

Cancellation: Please note that should you wish to cancel your application the following refund policy will strictly apply:

- Cancellation received by HERS-SA by 31 May 2021: 90% refund
- Cancellation received by HERS-SA by 30 June 2021: 50% refund
- Cancellation received by HERS-SA after 30 July 2021: no refund Institutions that are centrally sponsoring women and only covering the conference fee are strongly advised to communicate this in advance with their faculties and departments before providing HERS-SA with the nominated list of names.
