HERS-SA ACADEMY 2023

Sunday, 3th September - Thursday, 7th September 2023

APPLICATION PROCESS AND FEES

The fee for the 2023 ACADEMY is R23 500 (in-person) and R19 800 (online) inclusive of 15% VAT. The **IN-PERSON FEE** INCLUDES all ACADEMY costs, materials, refreshments, lunches and official programme dinners. The fee EXCLUDES delegate travel and accommodation costs (on a bed & breakfast), dinner on Tuesday evening, and daily parking costs at the hotel (i.e. day conference parking @ R30.00 per bay, per day – SUBJECT TO AVAILABILITY).

The **ONLINE FEE** includes an online hosting platform and support by an event hosting organisation but excludes catering and bag costs.

Upon receipt of an e-mail request from an institution's Human Resources division or an individual to reserve a place/s, HERS-SA will invoice either the institution or the individual for payment of the fee due. Only upon receipt of the fee, will delegates be provided with the link to the ACADEMY webpage where they can register for the ACADEMY.

Kindly note that places for the 2023 ACADEMY are limited so early bookings AND full payment of the ACADEMY fees are encouraged to secure a place/s. Should the ACADEMY fees not be paid in full by Thursday, 30 June 2023, the delegate/s space/s will be offered to the next interested party on our waiting list.

Cancellation: Please note that should you wish to cancel your application the following refund policy will strictly apply:

Cancellation received by HERS-SA by 31st May 2023: 90% refund.
Cancellation received by HERS-SA by 30th June 2023: 50% refund.
Cancellation received by HERS-SA after 31st July 2023: no refund. Refunds will not be
provided for cancellation requests received after 31st July 2023.

Requests to cancel registrants must be sent to <u>director@hers-sa.org.za</u> by 31st July 2023. Anyone who has purchased a registration and does not attend will NOT receive a refund. In case a delegate can't attend in person, changes made online will be charged for online attendance. Any changes after the 31st of July 2023 will be made with no refund for the price variance online.

This cancellation notice applies to attendee registration only and does not apply to hotel bookings. Contact the hotel directly for cancellation.

Delegate Substitution:

Substitution is permitted without incurring any additional fees at any meeting.

Any such modifications must be communicated in writing to our office at least 4 days before the event.

There will be no refund granted if a registered delegate does not cancel and does not show up for the ACADEMY.

Institutions that are centrally sponsoring women and only covering the conference fee are strongly advised to communicate this in advance with their faculties and departments before providing HERS-SA with the nominated list of names.
