DEAR PROSPECTIVE PIEKEMAN

With this we would like to congratulate you on your placement in Pieke PSO (Private Student Organisation). Pieke is a community that plays the same role in terms of experience and activities as a residence, for students who reside in private accommodation. Every Matie student is aware of the fact that a PSO is a unique organisation. Pieke is proud to be a visible, active community campus, without being limited to a single residence building.

Pieke was established in 1973 and have flourished over the past 46 years. We pride ourselves by our values of Honour, Excellence, Integrity and Service. Grounded by these values, Pieke has been extremely successful on a sport, social, cultural and academic level. Being part of the Rubix Cluster, Pieke has shown its capability of being a strong academic, sport and cultural contender among the residences. This is something for you, as a Piekeman, to look forward to and be a part of in the near future. We are known for our traditions and pride. Being a home away from home, Pieke is an established PSO that gives each individual a place to flourish. Pieke aims to provide for the needs of every Piekeman, whether it is sport, academics or culture. On a cultural level, Pieke Manssêr, our acapella group, is very well known on campus and have represented Stellenbosch University twice at the National Kleinsêr Competition. We are currently still the only male PSO that has won SU Acapella as well as Maties Mollasêr. SU Acapella, and in particular Pieke Manssêr, is one of the highlights for any Piekeman. In addition to sêr, Pieke has been a strong competitor in the annual Toneelfees, having won this event several times in the past. When it comes to the sport field, Pieke has been incredibly successful in a wide range of sporting activities. Our squash team has won the A league, against some of the strongest residences on campus, several times. We are the only PSO to have ever won the inter-residence swimming gala. Pieke is a strong competitor on the soccer and hockey fields, with both our teams participating in the strongest leagues. Pieke forms part of the PSO Barbarians rugby team, a team consisting out of players from different male PSOs. The PSO Barbarians is a force to be reckoned with in the Maties Residence Rugby League. We also participate in activities such as chess. In recent years Pieke has also performed in table tennis and recently won the second league title. When it comes to sport, Pieke has delivered several successful Maties sports men. We value academics, and in order to assist first year students with adapting to university academics, we have a mentorship program in place. The newcomers are assigned to a senior Piekeman, which acts as a mentor, to assist and guide the student with any queries. Our mentors have the necessary skills to provide the newcomers with any assistance they may require. As a men's PSO we have a lot of spirit, despite the fact that we don't live together in a residence. We maintain this spirit by organising numerous events throughout the year, which ranges from a formal House Dance to a Golf day. Pieke aims to create a home away from home, providing safety and security for every newcomers. It is therefore the mission of Pieke to maintain the unity within the House by treating each Piekeman as equal and providing a platform where it is possible to achieve your full potential.

PSO's are the heart and soul of Stellenbosch University. The 11 PSO's provide support to those students who do not live in residences, these students making up around 70% of students on campus. A PSO does not provide accommodation and meals (excluding the meals that form part of the Welcoming Package, of course). PSO students should therefore arrange private accommodation or daily transport, depending on whether the student prefers to live in Stellenbosch or drive to campus daily from surrounding suburbs.

During the welcoming week (22 January to 1 February 2020) we are going to help you become a true Matie. A full program with exciting activities has already been planned; to ensure that you get to know Matieland before classes commence, and receive the best start to your student life. The aim of this welcoming week is to ensure that you are prepared for your University career, what lies ahead and for you to find a sense of belonging in your new community. We have assigned mentors to all of our first years to help you cope with the change from school to university. This program is designed to make provision for each and every one of our newcomers, so we are looking forward to meeting you and, more importantly, getting to know you.

You will also be taking part in all the various Connect activities during the course of this week. Connect is a weeklong, age-old tradition, where all the newcomers on campus prepare for the Connect "Vensters" (A production done outside on a stage with all the newcomers). Our Connect partner is Serruria Ladies' Residence, and it is sure to be a very successful journey. This is an excellent opportunity for us to showcase what we have worked towards throughout the welcoming week, as well as our projects and aims (regarding social impact and -wellness) for the coming year.

Another exciting aspects is that we are part of Rubix Cluster, along with several other residences and PSO's. This creates the platform for us to network with other students who we would not necessarily encounter otherwise. This also provides us access to physical spaces within residences to utilize. This includes dining halls, study areas, a deli and even sleeping facilities (which can be arranged should you need to stay on campus for a test). For private students staying off campus, the Cluster is here to provide a place to stay during the day when you are on campus. A new initiative for PSOs is that you are able to book your meals on your student card and enjoy the most affordable meals on campus at Metanoia, Nerina and Heemstede's dining hall. The cluster will also have monthly meals together at the different residences in our cluster. Above and beyond this, there will be regular study sessions where you will be given the opportunity to work together with other guys and girls in the cluster who are studying the same course as you. Rubix, together with Pieke as an individual community, aims to be an environment where social skills and academic excellence can be developed.

Our role as Welcoming leaders and First Years' Guardians is to ensure that you fit in comfortably in a diverse environment in Stellenbosch, as well as in Pieke, and that you feel comfortable in taking part in the activities Pieke will offer you. There is a wide range of activities that we offer, and it is our job to make sure that you enjoy each one of them. Your care, wellbeing and safety will be our first priority. Any problems that you might possibly encounter can be brought under our attention, and we will do everything in our power to help you solve the problem.

Regarding the First meeting, please find the following details:

The first meeting is where we, as House Committee, meet the new Pieke men of 2020. This is a general information session. Your parents are also invited, should they wish to attend the event. At this event, we give you and your parents a brief overview of what Pieke is, and what you can expect from Pieke. Should your parents have any questions or concerns, they can also ask us these questions at this event. It should not last longer than 45 minutes, after which your parents are free to meet the House committee personally, and get to know us, or leave to continue with their day.

Additional merchandise will be sold at the first meeting (Cash only for these sales). Please bring the completed form to the first meeting so that you may receive your packet. We only ordered 150 clothing packets for 2020 with limited sizes, it will work on a first come first serve principle. Please bring along a bag to registration to put all your Pieke merch in.

Please note that Pieke PSO is not allowed to receive any cash for the Welcoming package on the day, only the completed form.

SERVICE

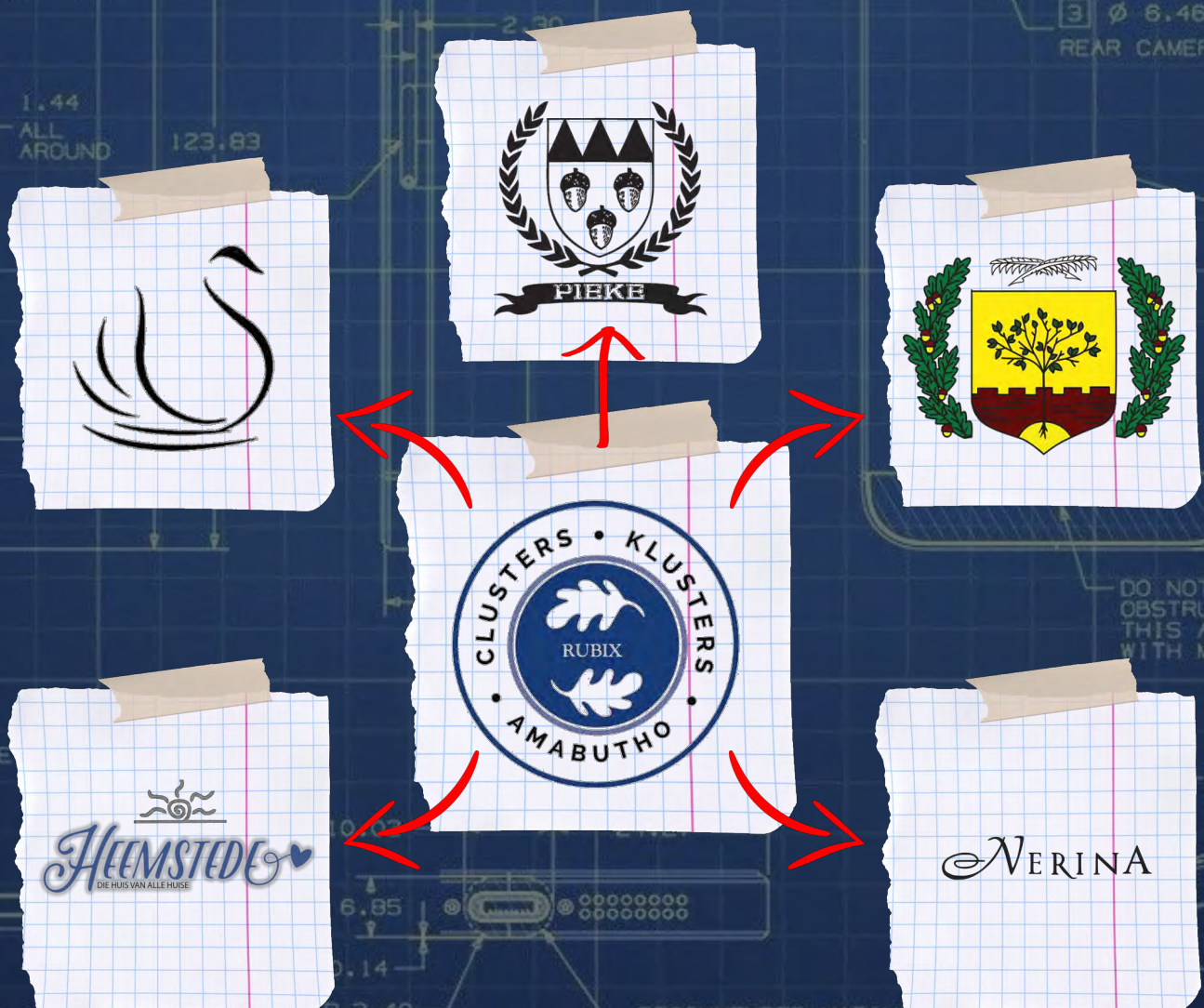

Pieke PSO forms part of the Rubix Cluster, with Venustia PSO as well as Heemstede, Nerina and Metanoia making up the residences of Rubix Cluster. Rubix also offers a variety of events throughout the year, from socials to academic study groups. Rubix Cluster has benefited immensely from the joining of the gentlemen of Pieke and we encourage you to stay involved so that we can expand and improve the Rubix community.

CHARGING FIRST YEAR PACKETS TO STUDENT ACCOUNTS

Welcome to the PSO community of Stellenbosch University! You have been assigned to a PSO (private student organisation) due to the fact that you have not elected to stay in a residence in 2020. During the annual welcoming period in the beginning of the year, residences and PSOs take responsibility for exposing first years to Stellenbosch University in a welcoming manner.

Because PSO's do not have a dining hall (although some PSO's will arrange meals for their students in dining halls during the welcoming period) where students can enjoy meals, PSO first years are provided with "welcoming packages". These packages usually consist of a number of meals, clothing, water bottles, caps and other items unique to the particular PSO. During PSO registration on the first day of Welcoming (Wednesday, 22 January 2020), you will have the option of purchasing one of these welcoming packages at a set price (which may vary from PSO to PSO). Each PSO will also offer different options (both clothing and meals, only meals, only clothing, etc.) that students can then select. Please see the bottom of this email for more information.

Stellenbosch University utilizes a cashless system to allow students to purchase these packages hassle free. You, or your parents or guardian, will have to sign an acknowledgment of debt on the day so that the clothing, food, etc. for the welcoming period can be made available to you. After registration the cost will be charged to your student account to be paid with all other student-related expenses. **Please note that once the form is signed you will be liable for the costs of the package selected, regardless of you having all the meals or not, or not wanting the clothing after the first few days.**

Acquiring the "welcoming package" is not compulsory, but we do want to encourage you to take the opportunity to do so as it will make your welcoming period a much more enjoyable experience. Please find attached the form for your completion. You are welcome to print the form and bring it along.
