The programme aims to fast track South Africa's skills production for the 21st century by funding the higher education costs of students studying towards a career in scarce skills that have been identified as critical to South Africa's economic development.

ISFAP AIMS TO ADDRESS THE FOLLOWING CHALLENGES THAT FACE SOUTH AFRICAN STUDENTS:

- Reducing the high dropout rate of poor and working-class students in the higher education and training sector
- Improving the employability of funded graduates
- Improving the country's skills profile, especially in occupations of high demand
- Improving the partnership between government, the private sector/business and higher education institutions in supporting poor and "missing middle" students.
