## THE KUEHNE + NAGEL INZUZO TRUST BURSARY SCHEME

### 1. Background

The Kuehne + Nagel Inzuzo Trust (the Trust) invests in the education and entrepreneurial development of young South Africans. The Trust was founded in 2012 by Kuehne + Nagel, one of the world's leading logistics companies. Kuehne + Nagel employs over 79,000 employees across 100 countries globally, including South Africa.

The Trust is firmly committed to supporting the sustainable growth of South Africa's economy, by facilitating the development of its young professionals and entrepreneurs. In this context, the Trust has provided multiple bursary awards to students pursuing their studies in logistics, supply chain management and other commerce streams.

The Trust is launching its 2019 Bursary Program to passionate young leaders. The bursary awards cover tuition, prescribed books and an accommodation allowance.

### 2. Criteria

Bursary applicants are required to satisfy the following criteria:

- Black South African women enrolled in their 2<sup>nd</sup> year, 3<sup>rd</sup> year, or post graduate studies at an accredited South African university. Applicable fields of study:
  - Bachelor of Commerce in Logistics
  - Diploma in Logistics Management
  - Bachelor of Commerce in Transport Economics
  - Bachelor of Commerce in Accounting
  - Bachelor of Commerce in Financial Management
  - Bachelor of Commerce in Information Systems
- A track record of academic excellence, evidenced by a minimum 60% average in the students' most recent year of study
- Strong leadership capability, demonstrated through active school, university or community engagement
- Demonstrable financial need

The closing date for applications is 15 February 2019.

### 3. Other Information

Bursary recipients are given an opportunity to gain hands on experience with Kuehne + Nagel, by doing vacation work during school holidays.

There is a mandatory work-back requirement for every year that bursary recipients are covered by the bursary scheme. This requirement may be waived by the Trust at its sole discretion.

#### 4. Application Process

<b>Step 1</b>	Candidates submit application documents: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Completed application form</li><li>○ Academic results (Grade 12, and all university results)</li><li>○ Confirmation of financial need</li></ul>	15 February 2019 (closing date)
<b>Step 2</b>	Shortlisted applicants will be invited to a face to face interview	February & March 2019
<b>Step 3</b>	Shortlisted candidates will be invited to a final round interview or case study presentation	March 2019
<b>Step 4</b>	Trust announces bursary awards	March 2019

Please note that applicants will be contacted after each step of the selection process to notify them of their application status.
