CANDIDATE VIDEO GUIDELINES

Please take note of the following video guidelines detailed below with regards to the 2021 Tygerberg Student Representative Council elections.

Given the present state of affairs and considering contemporary legislature related to Covid-19 which discourages large social gatherings, in an attempt to protect the health and safety of all students no in-person events related to the 2021/2022 TSR election may be held. Each candidate is required to produce and submit a video which is to be published on relevant Stellenbosch University associated social media platforms during the 2021/2022 election period. In committing to candidature the individual acknowledges and consents to the reproduction, publishing and the right of the Tygerberg Election Committee to withdraw the video at any given point should a candidate act in contravention of the Rules and Regulations governing the 2021 TSR Elections (see document attached).

- (a) Each candidate is required to produce and consent to a brief introductory video which introduces both the individual and their candidature. The following is to be included in the video:
 - (i) A brief introduction in which the candidate formally introduces themselves
 - (ii) A review of the candidates proposed manifesto
- (b) Each candidate is allotted a maximum of 15 minutes in which to deliver their address, however candidates are advised to keep videos brief.
- (c) All candidates are requested to wear appropriate semi-formal attire
- (d) Videos are to be recorded with a clear unobstructed view from the waist up in portrait mode.
- (e) A neutral background is advised.
- (f) Common courtesy is expected, refrain from foul language, vulgarity and obscenities. No personal attacks may be made on fellow students' candidature or commentary passed which infringes on the rights of fellow candidates.
- (g) The video should be submitted by the **3rd of August 2021 @ 23:59**
