Deputy Speaker Baker

- Amendments
 - There is no procedure for a vote of no confidence in members
 - The procedure for a presiding officer vote of no confidence
 - Eligibility criteria for a person to be selected to student parliament
 - Must be a registered Stellenbosch University Student
 - Must be entering into their second year or higher year of study at Stellenbosch University
 - The same minimum HEMIS requirements as decided in the university calendar
 - Speaker, deputy speaker and speaker of student imbizo will analyse all submissions

Speaker Villet

- There will be small grammatical changes to the document.
 - Floor is opened to debate:
 - Errors Raised with the Document:
 - To submit a vote of no confidence 2 weeks before the sitting
 - But you only get notice of proceedings 5 days before
 - This needs to be reconciled
 - Member Raises an issue with Constituency of the meeting
 - This meeting is not properly Constituted
 - Only a ordinary plenary sitting may reconsidered rules
 - Amendment to the rules can't be amended unless it has been circulated at least 14 days before the meeting
 - The only time rules may come before this house if the amendments have been heard by the commission
 - Speaker:
 - The notice was distributed to other members of the house and the SRC
 - The Student Assembly has not yet given a budget for mass mailers at the mass meeting
 - But there are pending issues that need to be voted on
 - Did not feel that the needs of students require to attend this meeting
 - SRC asked whether
 - Are the rules being amended rules of imbizo or student assembly
 - Speaker
 - Student assembly rules are being amended
 - The rules have been made by the student assembly
 - AAC raises the fact that reasonable notice was not given for this meeting

- Reasonable invitation was not given
 - Yanga Keva raises a point of order from the floor
 - Speaker needs to make a ruling on a point of order
 - Reason for haste is irrelevant irrelevant
 - Only a positive recommendation can allow for the policy considerations of this house
 - We can't have a debate on the rules until the meeting is properly constituted.
- Speaker issues a vote to determine whether we continue with this meeting or not
 - Vote on continuing with meeting
- Mr Claasen raises the following point
 - The power to make rules is within the student assembly
 - The rules we constitute are for certainty but don't determine whether we have the power to vote on a motion of no confidence
 - Speaker has a broad discretion to institute a proceedings that is fair
 - That may be challenged
- Mr Keva Raises the following point
 - The rules of the house are not sufficient
 - Any decision of this house must be made by way of motion
 - Presiding officer must decide whether the meeting is properly constituted and must therefore
