We welcome applications from students with disabilities. We adhere to the UNCRPD (2007) definition of disability. By completing this form, you help us to form a clearer picture of your needs, which will enable us to see how we could reasonably support you, should you be accepted to SU.

As in the case of all other applicants, first we consider your academic merits and whether you comply with the admission criteria for the course that you want to apply for. Then we will consider what type of support is reasonable and practical for the specific programme to which you have applied.

We will respect your privacy and keep your information confidential. However, we must share relevant information with key academic, administrative and support staff members. They need such information to determine how we might best support you, should you be admitted for studies at SU.

Please upload the completed form and all supporting documents (e.g. any copies of medical or psychological proof of your condition and/or disability) as one combined document to your application profile (https://student.sun.ac.za/signup/) by the closing date.
