

Master of Therapeutic Nutrition (thesis option)

Application procedure and closing date

Apply online at www.maties.com by **30 September** of the previous year. Applications for prospective international students close on **31 August**. Only a limited number of students are selected annually.

Duration of programme

The programme extends over a minimum of two years.

Programme description

The programme comprises a research project (100% of credits) with no theoretical modules. If the academic year extends over 40 weeks, you must use 45 hours per week to complete the programme as a full-time student. If you are a part-time student, however, you must use 22,5 hours per week to complete the programme.

You must plan and implement a research project and submit a thesis or, preferably, two articles for publication in a peer-reviewed journal, in the format specified in the study guide.

Assessment and examination

- The final degree mark is calculated as follows:
 - protocol – 15%;
 - project execution – 10%;
 - average of the internal and external examiners' marks for the thesis – 65%; and
 - oral examination – 10%.
- An oral examination by the examiners is compulsory.
