

2.12 Postgraduate Diploma in Project Management

Admission requirements

- A relevant bachelor's degree.
- A minimum of two years' experience in a project management position.
- Complete the SHL assessment battery (Numeric, Verbal and Logical Reasoning) aligned with predefined programme requirements

Further requirements

In addition to the requirements above, you must:

- Submit a comprehensive CV indicating all of your work experience.
- Submit one entrance essay. The entrance essay of between 400-500 words should focus on the prospective student's personal and external development. The essay provides insights concerning the student's motivation to study and provides evidence of writing ability.

Selection

The number of students selected will be influenced by, among other things, staff capacity, availability of the School's resources as well as academic merit and University transformation objectives. As staff capacity and resources may fluctuate from year to year, the number of students selected can also differ from year to year.

Should the applicants that meet the admission requirements exceed the capacity of USB, a selection process is applied by a selection committee. The criteria that are applied by the committee, include multiple components supporting the USB's drive for inclusivity and upholding our global standard for learning. The USB selection committee considers work experience, qualifications, assessment results, writing ability and motivation for further development when choosing suitable candidates. These criteria are used to rank the applicants in order of suitability, and to finalise the list of selected applications.
