CANSA Call for Applications: Cancer Research Grants for 2018

Researchers are hereby invited to apply for funding from CANSA (the Cancer Association of South Africa). Funding is made available for **cancer research** and will be awarded for 1-3 years.

The following topics are relevant for this round of applications:

- Epidemiology and determinants of the burden of cancer in South African populations
- Health seeking behaviours and early detection and diagnosis of cancer
- Health promotion and risk reduction of cancer, with a particular focus on behavioural risk reduction
- Optimal patient care including rehabilitation and palliative care services
- Other health services and health system research relating to the above categories
- Research relating to cancer biology/biochemistry/molecular biology as these relate to early detection, risk reduction and patient care

The **process** for submitting your application is outlined below:

- 1. Complete the research proposal template (attached)
- 2. Email the completed research proposal + ethics approval and other relevant documentation (as required) to Nugent Lewis before **17 May 2017.**
- 3. You may receive recommendations emanating from our internal administrative review process
- 4. Please ensure that you and your witnesses sign sections 26 and 27
- You must submit your final copy of the application to <u>nugent@sun.ac.za</u> before
 31 May 2017. No late applications will be considered.
- The maximum amount to apply for funding is currently R400 000 per applicant per annum, for up to 3 years. (75% will be awarded by CANSA; Stellenbosch University will contribute the remaining 25%)
