- ◆ Social cohesion and identity
- ◆ Societal change and the evolution of modern society

These four thematic focus areas provide the basis for a structured research agenda to improve the understanding of social conditions and issues.

New applicants to the Human and Social Dynamics Funding Instrument are invited to:

- ◆ Submit applications in accordance with the strategy and eligibility criteria, as set out in the Call Framework document for funding commencing in 2018
- ◆ Submit ONLY ONE application per principal investigator. Additional applications will not be considered.
