Herewith below please find information on research funding by the **Russel Sage Foundation** for the interdisciplinary call: **Integrating Biology and Social Science Knowledge (BioSS)**.

This call supports innovative **social science research on social and economic outcomes** that improves our understanding of the interactive mechanisms by which **environmental influences affect biological mechanisms**, and vice versa. This includes research that:

- estimates how the structured nature of the social environment and intra- and intergenerational social inequalities affect biological processes;
- identifies which indicators of biological processes interact with the social environment to affect different life domains;
- yields new conceptual frameworks that holistically characterise the complex relationships among biological, psychological and environmental factors to predict a range of behavioural and social outcomes.
