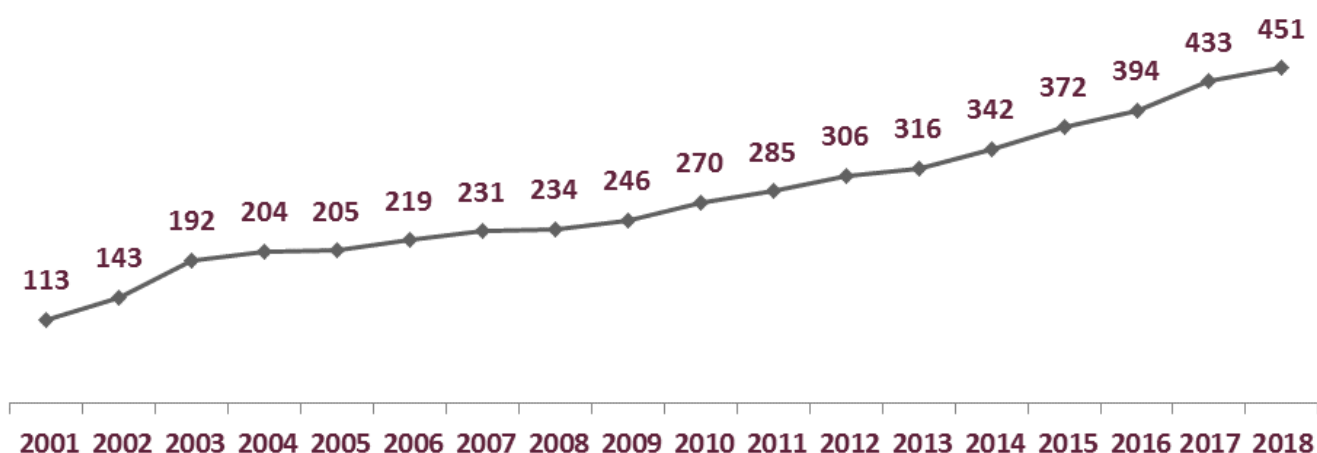

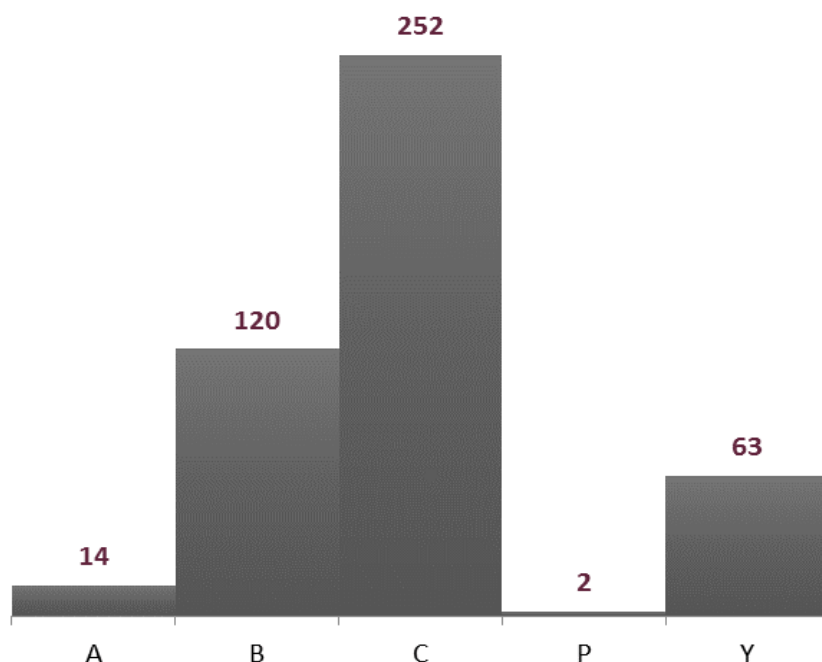
SU Rated researchers in 2018

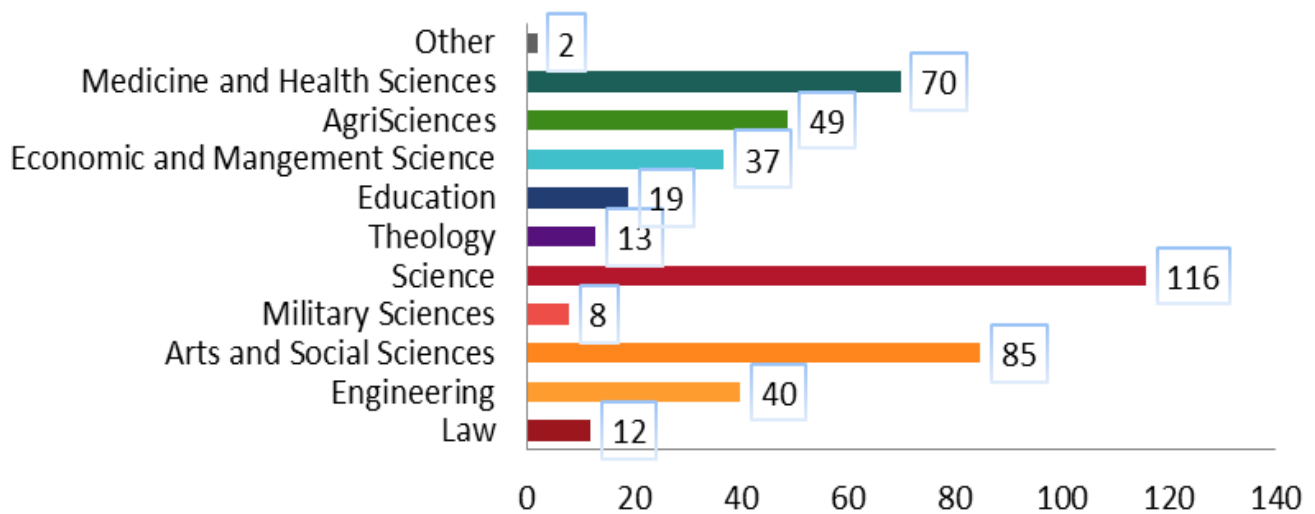

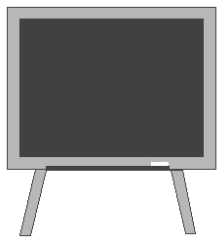

2018 Rated Researchers per Faculty

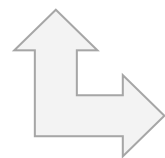

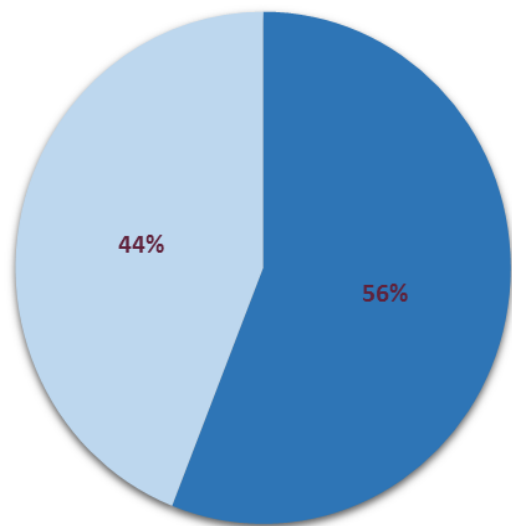

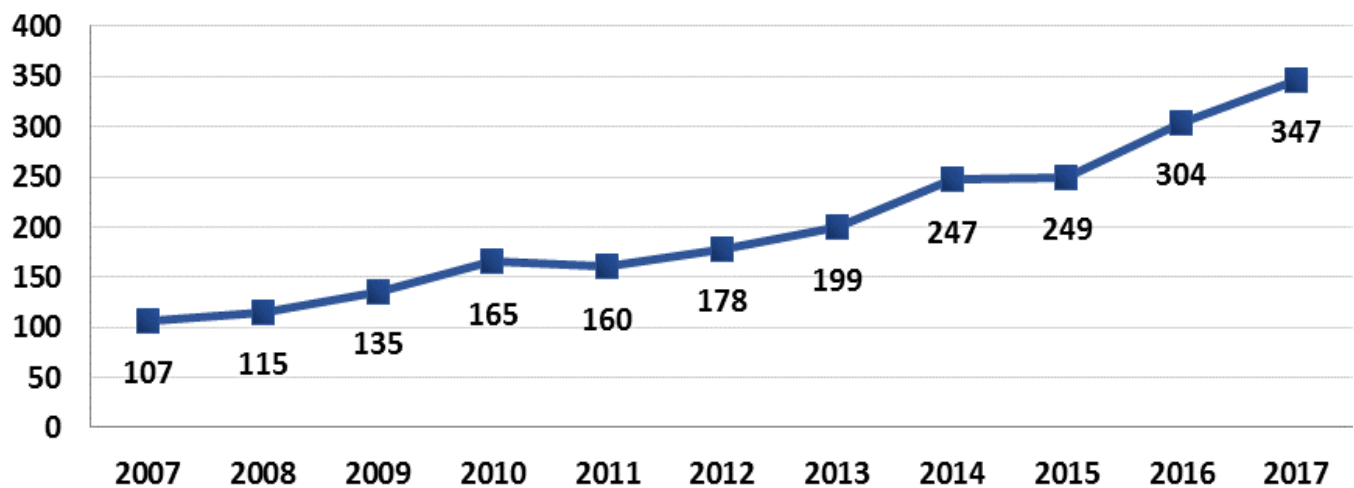

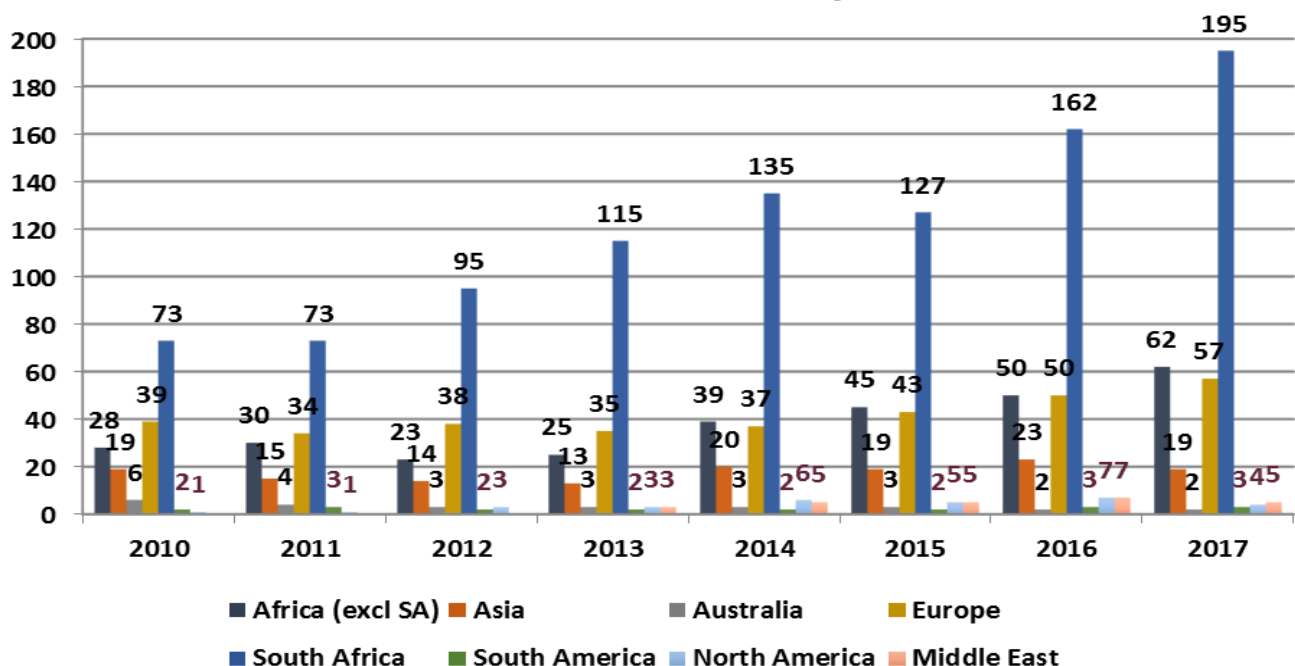

2007-2017 SU PostDoc Growth



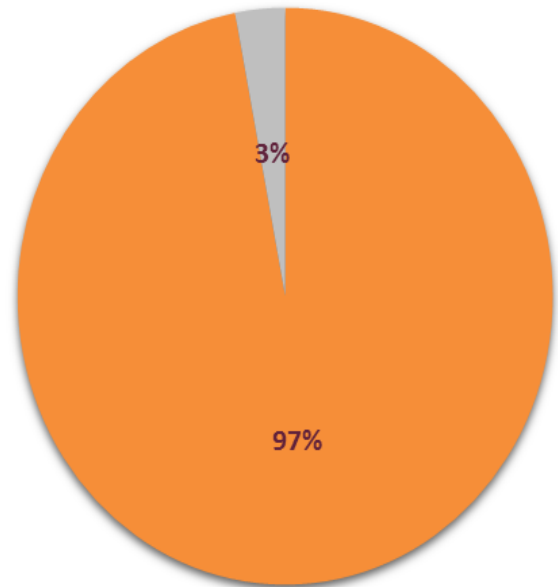
2010-2017 SU PostDocs per continent

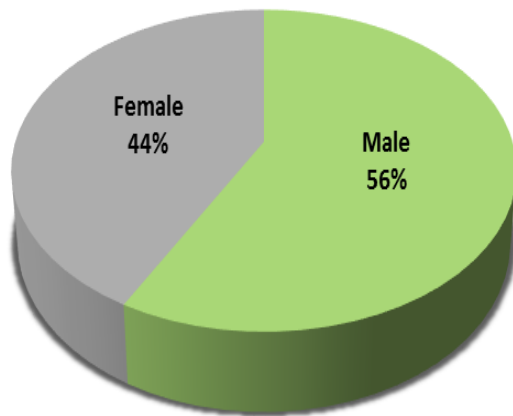

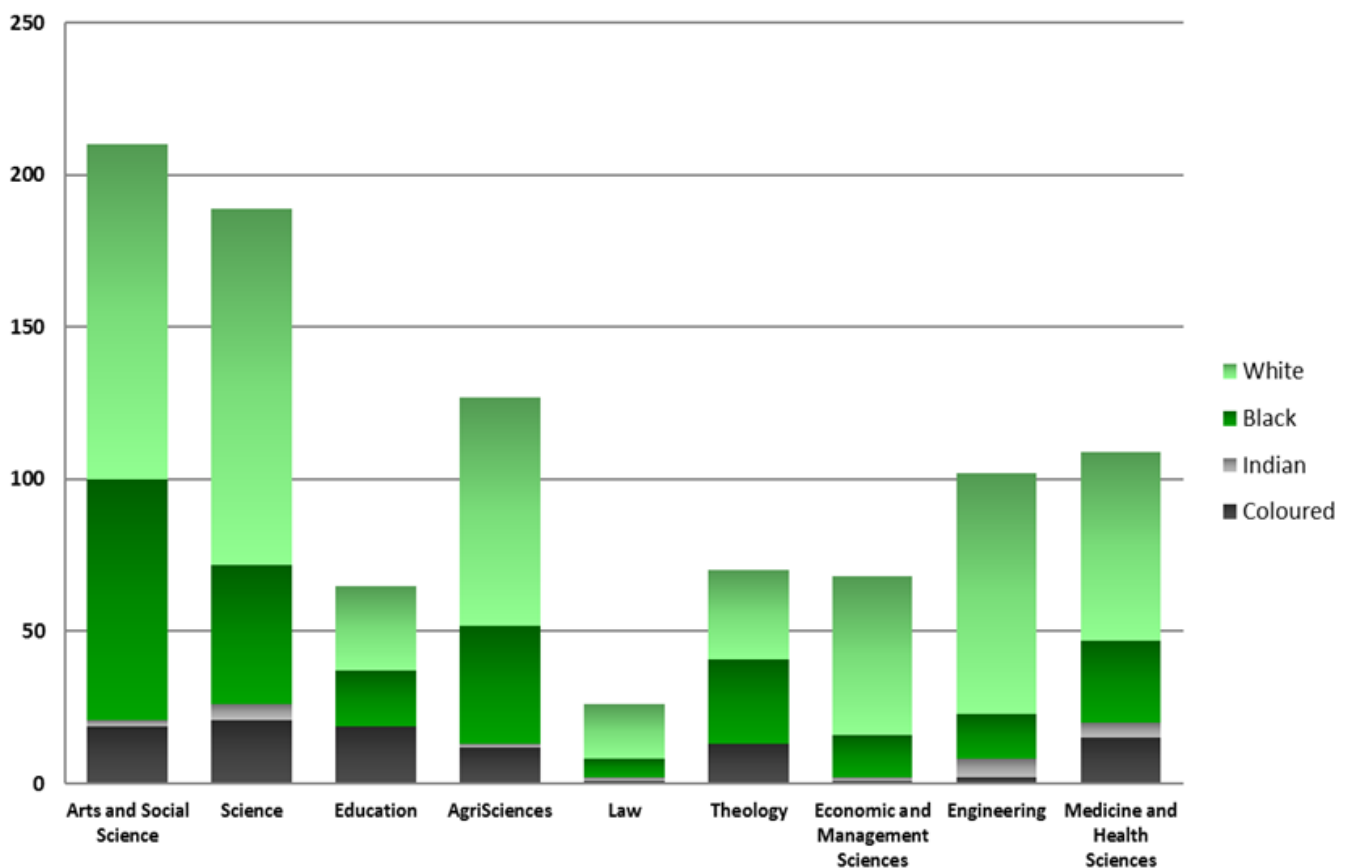
2013-2016 Doctorates Awarded according to gender

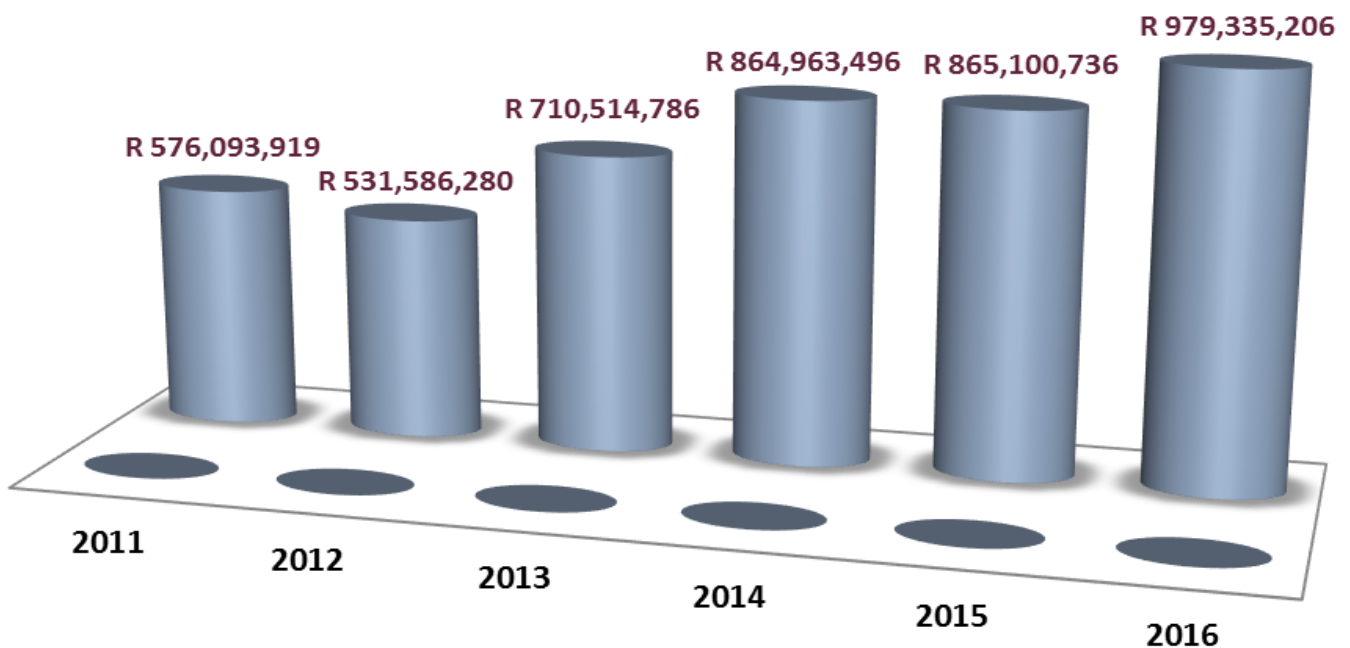

SU also had the highest research publication output per capita in South Africa for 2016 publications.

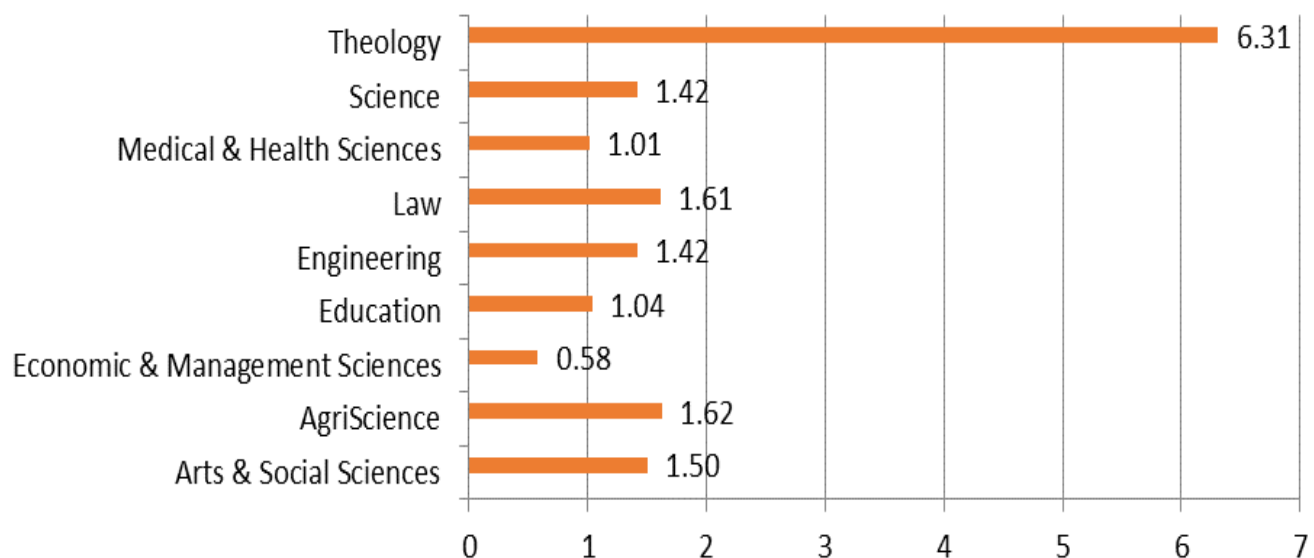
