



2018 Rated Researchers per category








Postdocs at SU during 2017



2007-2017 SU PostDoc Growth




2010-2017 SU PostDocs per continent




2013-2016 Doctorates Awarded according to gender



SU has had the highest weighted research output (publications, research masters and doctoral degrees awarded) per capita in South Africa for for 2016 publications.


