














Postdocs at SU during 2018



2007-2018 SU PostDoc Growth




2010-2018 SU PostDocs per continent



SU has had the highest weighted research output (publications, research masters and doctoral degrees awarded) per capita in South Africa for 2016 publications, namely 3.11


