

PG Scholarship Programme (PSP)

Guideline for Supervisor Support Letters

- The applicant must submit a supervisor support letter prepared by the prospective supervisor for either the Master's or Doctoral degree programme;
- Support letters must be prepared on a formal letterhead and should ideally be signed by the
 prospective supervisor (or current supervisor if the student is already enrolled for the relevant
 degree programme)
- Date stamp for the support letter
- Addressed to: Prof Eugene Cloete (Vice Rector: Research, Innovation and Postgraduate studies in his capacity as Chair of the Postgraduate Scholarship Committee)
- The letter should address the following topics:
 - 1. Confirmation that the supervisor commits to supervision of the student for the intended degree.
 - 2. Indication on the nature of the research (topic).
 - 3. If applicable, confirmation of the intended research study title.
 - 4. Reasons for supporting the student's scholarship application.
 - 5. Indication of possible co-funding (if applicable).
