

- 1 December 2022 (for conferences between January to April 2023).






Webinar on Understanding Academic Authorship, 1 September 2022

Authorship and publication credit is the currency system of the academic community, which has both positive and negative implications for researchers.


This webinar covers:

This workshop, taking place on Stellenbosch campus, covers how to use MS PowerPoint well to create impactful slides for formal presentations.




MS Excel for Research Data Management 12 September 2022 (in-person)
