Niemand sal 2020 sommer vergeet nie. Dit sal tereg onthou word as 'n besonder uitdagende tyd. Wat as die spreekwoordelike “jaar van volmaakte sig” begin het, het vinnig in 'n maalkolk van onsekerheid ontaard weens die koronaviruspandemie. Ons moes almal vasbyt om op koers te bly met ons doelwitte.

Almal het hul deel gedoen – van studente wat gesondheidswerkers in die frontlinie vrywillig bygestaan het, navorsers wat multidisiplinêre projekte van stapel gestuur het, en tegnoloë wat robotte in 'n hospitaal ontplooi het sodat spesialiste op 'n afstand saalrondes kon doen, tot ingenieurs wat met 'n 3D-drukker onderdele vir asemhalingstoestelle en gesigskerms vir gesondheidsorgwerkers vervaardig het, en kollegas wat uitgereik het na die groter gemeenskap met kospakkies vir huishoudings in nood. Dít is hoe ons Maties ken!

Jou tyd hier by ons het jou voorberei om leiding te neem en uit te blink in 'n diverse wêreld, danksy 'n omgewing waarin jy 'n transformerende studente-ervaring kon hê. Mag jy wat jy hier geleer het met vrug toepas, en mag die US se waardes – uitnemendheid, deernis, billikheid, respek en verantwoordbaarheid – jou rigsgoer bly.

A colleague tells me of a young medical doctor who graduated last year, who recently said how relieved she was that she did not have to tackle “this chaotic year” as a final-year student. You did – and with great success at that. Well done!

2020 will not be easily forgotten. It will rightly be remembered as an extremely challenging time. What started off as the proverbial “year of perfect vision” soon turned into one fraught with uncertainty due to the coronavirus pandemic. All of us had to dig deep to stay on course with our goals.

The comprehensive plans our University had at the start of the year were swiftly scaled down to only two overall objectives: ensuring that our students could complete their academic year and that our institution remain sustainable for future intakes. I believe we have succeeded in this.

When face-to-face tuition was suspended on campuses nationwide in March, we rapidly switched to online emergency remote teaching, learning and assessment. While there were some glitches, most were soon resolved. Twaalf klein fisiese gradeplegtighede (vier per dag) sal in die Endlersaal van die Konservatorium op ons Stellenboschkampus gehou word vir die verlening van doktorsgrade (ook dié uit die siklus van Maart/April 2020), eredoktorsgrade, die Kanselierstoekennings, en die Kanseliersmedalje.

Fakulteitspesifieke aanlyn plegtighede sal vir die res van die graduandi-kategorieë gehou word, wat dus hulle kwalifikasies in absentia sal ontvang. Die skakels na hierdie plegtighede sal op 14 Desember vrygestel word.

Daarbenewens hou ons Fakulteit Geneeskunde en Gesondheidswetenskappe op onderskeidelik 18 November en 14 Desember twee fisiese toewydingsplegtighede (van aangesig tot aangesig) op Tygerbergkampus.

December 2020 graduation ceremonies

We are celebrating the academic achievements of thousands of Stellenbosch University (SU) students graduating in December this year. Graduation will occur in a format that complies with Covid-19 regulations and will not put the health and safety of graduands or their guests at risk.

The Rectorate approved a hybrid graduation model that consists of small face-to-face ceremonies from 14 to 16 December, as well as faculty-specific online ceremonies.

Twelve small physical graduation ceremonies (four per day) will be held in the Endler Hall of the Conservatoire on our Stellenbosch Campus for the conferral of doctorates (including those from the March/April 2020 cycle), honorary doctorates, the Chancellor's Awards and the Chancellor's Medal.

Faculty-specific online ceremonies will be held for the remainder of the categories of graduands, who will therefore receive their qualifications in absentia. The links to these ceremonies will be released on 14 December.

In addition, our Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences is holding two face-to-face pledge ceremonies on Tygerberg Campus – on 18 November and 14 December.

- Alle graduandi en gaste ontvang unieke sitpleknommers. Moet asseblief nie sitplekke ruil of van sitplek verander nie, want die sitplekrekord en -geskiedenis sal vir enige moontlike kontaksporing gebruik word.
- Alle lokale word sowel voor as na elke plegtigheid deeglik volgens die goedgekeurde Covid-19-protokol skoongemaak en ontsmet.
- Dit is verpligtend vir sowel graduandi as gaste om vir die volle duur van die plegtigheid 'n masker te dra, ook wanneer graduandi oor die verhoog stap.
- Hoewel graduandi oor die verhoog sal stap, sal die Registrateur geen graadserpe omhang nie om aan Covid-19-protokol te voldoen.
- Handhaaf asseblief te alle tye 'n veilige afstand van 1,5m van ander.
- Dit is verbode om enige kos in die lokaal in te bring of te eet. Slegs water word in die lokaal toegelaat.
- Ons versoek vriendelik dat u die lokaal so vinnig moontlik ná die geleentheid verlaat sodat skoonmaak en ontsmetting met die oog op die volgende plegtigheid kan begin.

Rachel Kachaje was vir meer as 25 jaar 'n gestremdheidsaktivis en voorstaander vir gelyke geleenthede en regte vir mense met gestremdhede in Malawi, die Afrika-streek en internasionaal. Kachaje was bekend vir haar vermoë om jong mense met gestremdhede te inspireer en vir haar vergestaltung van die waardes van medelye, respek, uitnemendheid, verantwoordelikheid en gelykheid.

Kachaje, wat op driejarige ouderdom gestremd raak weens polio, was werksaam by die Nasionale Bank van Malawi toe sy vir die eerste keer by die gestremdheidsbeweging in Malawi aangesluit het. In die 1990's word Kachaje medestigter van die Federasie van Gestremdeheidsorganisasies (FEDOMA) en verteenwoordig FEDOMA hierna in die Suider-Afrika Gestremdeheidsfederasie (SAFOD).

Sy is as Minister van Gestremdheid- en Bejaardesake in Malawi aangestel en in 2004 ontvang sy 'n Malawi-menseregtoekenning asook 'n diversiteitsleiertoekeuning. Kachaje was deel van die baanbrekersonderhandelinge van die VN-konvensie oor die regte van mense met gestremdhede (UNCRPD) en het bygedra tot besprekings rondom die Millennium-ontwikkelingsdoelwitte (MOD's).

Kachaje het daarop gefokus om die agendas van mense met gestremdhede in die algemeen, en veral vroue en meisies met gestremdhede, te bevorder. Dit was haar missie om regte vir mense met gestremdhede te bepleit en te bevorder en om 'n lewe te lei wat hulle altyd op 'n positiewe wyse sou beïnvloed.

for her creative and visionary leadership in elevating the debate on disability to regional and global platforms; for challenging prejudiced notions of disability and advancing the inclusion of people with disabilities; and for her generosity of spirit through her selfless dedication to knowledge transfer and engaged citizenship to improve the lives of people with disabilities.

Rachel Kachaje was a disability activist for over 25 years, advocating for equal opportunities and rights for people with disabilities in Malawi, the African region and internationally. Kachaje was known for her ability to inspire young people with disabilities and for her embodiment of the values of compassion, respect, excellence, accountability and equity.

Kachaje, who became disabled at the age of three due to a polio outbreak, was working for the National Bank of Malawi when she first joined the disability movement in Malawi. She co-founded the Federation of Disability Organisations (FEDOMA) in the 1990s and represented it in the Southern Africa Federation of the Disabled (SAFOD).

She was elected Minister of Disability and Elderly Affairs in Malawi and in 2004 received a Malawi Human Rights Award and a Diversity Leader Award. She was part of the landmark negotiations of the UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (UNCRPD) and contributed to the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) discussions.

Kachaje had a proven ability in advancing the agendas of people with disabilities in general, and in particular women and girls with disabilities. Her mission was to advocate and promote rights for people with disabilities and to lead a life that would always affect them in a positive manner.

Meddling by consent? Brazil's strategy of democracy promotion through UNASUR

The study evaluated Brazil's role within UNASUR (the Union of South American Nations) to promote democracy in Bolivia, Paraguay and Venezuela. Drawing on the theoretical concept of consensual hegemony, Brazil's leadership capacity was examined by the degree of Brazil's domestic economic and political strength, the level of ideological coherence within the region and the involvement of external powers.

Brokering, mediating and translating rural development: Land and agricultural reform in the Southern Cape

Many rural development projects have been unsuccessful due to misguided policy and ignorance of local power dynamics. This study examined the agency of brokers and mediators in a land redistribution and honeybush production project in the Southern Cape. The study identified brokers in a mission village, government departments and the science council involved. Long-term ethnographic fieldwork and the analysis of policy and planning revealed the role of local brokers in manipulating officials and mediating resources. Development implementers and recipients have different logics about project opportunities. Mediation needs to be recognised as an intrinsic part of the development process.

Maternal mental illness, infant growth and infant psychomotor functioning in rural Masaka district, Uganda: A longitudinal cohort study

Maternal mental illness manifests at a critical stage in infants' lives and may affect their psychomotor functioning and growth. This longitudinal cohort study investigated the association between maternal mental illness, infants' psychomotor function and growth in the rural Masaka district, Uganda. Findings from this study showed a high prevalence of maternal mental illness, which was also a significant predictor of infant growth and psychomotor development. The study improves understanding of the impacts of maternal mental illness on child development and heightens the urgency for the implementation of early interventions for both mothers and infants – particularly those in rural areas.

LAPPEMAN, Maura (Psychology)

Stillbirths at Khayelitsha Hospital: Issues in the provision of care

This study offers a sensitive understanding of care in the context of stillbirth in Khayelitsha. Limited engagement between patient and healthcare providers was founded partly on deep cultural and socio-economic differences between many staff and patients, and on varying degrees of expectation of care on the part of different role players. In the overburdened healthcare system (where both staff and patients are often traumatised), silence can be a way in which a system defends itself against what it knows it cannot provide. Challenges in healthcare provision are complex, and the study has implications for the organisation of care in South Africa.

Exploring the implementation of a community health worker programme for maternal and child health in the rural Eastern Cape, South Africa

This study explored the processes underpinning the delivery of a community health worker programme to improve maternal and child health in rural South Africa. It used an implementation science approach, focusing on research questions related to health workers' fidelity to training, client responses to and engagement with the programme, and contextual aspects that affect the programme's delivery. The findings emphasise the importance of continued training, client and community consultation and identification of contextual challenges to make programme implementation more effective. They also highlight the need to adopt a human-centred approach to designing and implementing community health worker programmes.

MULLER-KLUITS, Noreth (Social Work)

Experiences of adults with acquired physical disabilities of social work support in a South African context

People who acquire a physical disability later in life often need to make adjustments to manage activities of daily living. Social workers provide support services to people with disabilities and their families. This qualitative study explored the experiences of people with an acquired physical disability regarding social work support. Community violence, communicable diseases and road accidents were contributing factors to participants' acquired disability. The findings of this study indicate that social workers, as social educators and advocates, play a vital role within the multi-disciplinary rehabilitation team, and their expertise and skills can be shared on different platforms, including research.

A critical discourse analysis of drone warfare and drone norm lifecycles

This study conducted a critical discourse analysis of drones and targeted killing to probe modes of future wars and contested international norms. The role played by the USA's justificatory norm setting and contesting policy entrepreneurship of established norms with speech acts aimed at drone normalisation was analysed. Normalisation occurring through 'drone war' film genres in cinematography in popular culture was probed. Resistance against normalisation of drones by various United Nations special rapporteurs and transnational global feminist organisations was assessed. The study raises concerns about future wars, executive-legislative relations and the rise of drone-enabled surveillance states that have geopolitical implications.

A wellness programme for mothers living in a high-risk community in the Western Cape to promote their personal and parental competencies

This multi-phase intervention study sought to design, implement and evaluate a contextualised wellness programme for mothers seeking to enhance their personal and parental strengths. Using a participatory action research case study design, systematically reviewed literature was integrated with contextual data derived from focus group inputs from social worker stakeholders and participant feedback to inform both the content and the process of the wellness programme. Formative process and summative evaluation findings confirmed that improved parental competencies were contingent on and energised by the participants' experiences of feeling that they mattered and that their own wellness was as much a priority as their children's.

Mental illness and health seeking of adults and children: A critical ethnography of Karamoja, north-eastern Uganda

This critical ethnographic study examined lay explanatory models of mental illness and health seeking among nomadic pastoralists affected by humanitarian crises among the Karimojong of Uganda. It provides an in-depth understanding of mental health issues among the Karimojong. This study is of critical public health significance and assists in revealing the broader socio-economic and political issues that impact well-being in Karamoja. Consequently, it provides novel and important insights that can inform the design of culturally sensitive and contextually appropriate mental health interventions for the Karimojong and similar populations in Uganda.

By die 2018 Llangollen internasionale musiekeisteddfod in Wallis, het die Koor in die kategorieë vir Oop, Jeug, en Gemengde Kore deelgeneem en al drie kategorieë gewen.

The Chancellor's Award is awarded to Mr André van der Merwe to honour his extraordinary contribution as the musical director of the Stellenbosch University Choir for the past 17 years. Under his leadership, the Choir has won numerous national and international awards and is ranked number 1 on the prestigious Interkultur World Ranking List.

At the World Choir Games in 2014 and 2016, the Choir won all three categories in which it participated, achieving the highest mark in the history of the competition. At the 2018 Llangollen International Musical Eisteddfod in Wales, the Choir competed in the categories for Open, Youth, and Mixed Choirs and won all three categories.

Windows on South African art music in the European tradition

Although South African art music in the European tradition has a history spanning a century, no comprehensive overview has yet been written. Nine articles on widely diverging topics, written over the course of seventeen years, are brought together to highlight some particularly relevant aspects of this tradition. The changing musical culture in our country provides the context within which to subject South African art music in the European tradition to a comprehensive critique and grapple with the question of its future, with the hope that it will find a meaningful place within the 'poly-phonic' concert which is South African music.

Wilfried Hiller's geistliche Werke

Although Wilfried Hiller (born 1941) ranks as one of the most-performed composers for the stage in post-war Germany, his highly significant sacred works are not well-known, are hardly ever performed and have not attracted much scholarly attention. This study is the first comprehensive and penetrating investigation of these innovative works. It examined their biographical and cultural-historical context, their link to earlier and contemporaneous visual artists and their provocative theological orientation and succeeds in unlocking their idiosyncratic stylistic characteristics. In this sense, the study represents a major contribution to the growing research on Wilfried Hiller.

Music and militarisation during the period of the South African Border War (1966–1989): Perspectives from Paratus

Against the backdrop of the Cold War, the South African apartheid government believed that it had to protect the last remnants of Western civilization on the African continent against a communist onslaught. Civilians were made aware of this perceived threat through civilian and military channels such as the media, education and the private business sector. By means of examples from the South African Defence Force magazine, *Paratus* (formerly known as *Commando*), this study illustrates that music served as conduit in the process of militarisation of South African society during the time of the South African Border War.

FAFOWORA, Bimbo Lolade (Journalism)

Media construction and representation of women in political leadership positions: A study of selected news media outlets in Nigeria

Despite the acceptance of women's political participation globally, women in such positions are still regarded as 'others'. Situated within the intersection of media, politics and gender studies, this study analysed the construction and representation of women as political leaders in four national Nigerian newspapers that could perpetuate gender stereotypes, leading to the marginalisation and subordination of women. Within the interpretive research paradigm, the study hinged on framing, media hegemony and feminist theory. The study concluded that women are framed out of the Nigerian media space and that these media were sites for the reproduction of disempowering patriarchal discourses.

Regional economic resilience: Exploring industrial decline in Bulawayo Metropolitan Province, Zimbabwe

This study analysed regional economic resilience following a protracted period of industrial decline in Bulawayo Metropolitan Province in Zimbabwe. Using the economic resilience concept and theories of regional development, factors behind industrial decline and firm resilience strategies were analysed. Industrial decline has 'locked in' the economy of Bulawayo in a path of economic decline, altering the structure of the economy, now dominated by micro, small and medium enterprises constituting approximately 90% of firms. Small firms were found to be more resilient, and firm resilience, economic diversification, firm linkages and regional patriotism were found to be important determinants of economic resilience in Bulawayo.

KOSGEI, Jauquelyne (English Studies)

Imaginaries of oceanic histories in oral and written texts from the Kenyan coast

This study presents an analysis of selected oral and written texts from the Kenyan coast. It shows how local oral narratives – in the form of performance poetry, oral history and storytelling – that were collected during field work imagine Indian Ocean histories differently to dominant written narratives, which frequently draw on foreign sources. By foregrounding local oral narratives and indigenous knowledges, the study reveals new facts, and narrates a littoral sensibility from the perspective of the local people at the Kenyan coast. In this way, the study represents an alternative archive that challenges the existing, often quite narrow, representations of this area.

MAKADZANGE, Panganai Francis (Evaluation Studies)

A study of the institutionalisation of the national monitoring and evaluation systems in Zimbabwe and Botswana

The aim of the study was to assess the extent to which Zimbabwe and Botswana's national monitoring and evaluation (M&E) systems are institutionalised. The study's research questions were addressed by conducting a study within the revised International Atlas of Evaluation framework – the first of its kind to provide a systematic overview of M&E systems in various parts of the world. The main findings of the study show that both countries have made progress in institutionalising their national M&E systems. However, more is yet to be realised and deliberate efforts are required to address the important institutional constraints highlighted in this study.

Vergil's menagerie: Animal imagery in the "Aeneid"

This study investigated Vergil's use of animal imagery in the "Aeneid". It examines the Latin author's manipulation of existing animal imagery and his introduction of new animals to the epic repertoire, which make his work stand apart from the earlier Greek epics. Seven species were selected for in-depth study: the snake, lion, deer, wolf, dove, eagle and owl. Passages where these animals feature were analysed together with corresponding passages from Homer and selected passages from Greek and Latin natural historians. These analyses revealed not only Vergil's innovative use of animal imagery, but also the inextricable role that animals play in the "Aeneid".

Crafting anti-stereotypes: Creating space for critical engagement through art

The study provides a contribution to the discourse on xenophobia and Afrophobia by highlighting the impact of discrimination on a school environment in Botswana. The aim of this study was to explore visual arts as a tool for learners to negotiate social and cultural meanings, to inform understandings of the self and explore the extent to which art processes can facilitate safe spaces for learners to openly engage in dialogue on discrimination. Social justice education with specific reference to art processes is shown as a necessary stepping stone towards multicultural education to enable more equal opportunities for all learners.

Argumentation involving account giving and self-presentation in Tanzanian parliamentary debates: A pragma-dialectical perspective

The study investigated the argumentative reality in the resolution of differences of opinion involving account giving and self-presentation in Tanzanian parliamentary debates in Kiswahili assuming the pragma-dialectical theory of argumentation as main theory and account-giving model as complementary theory. The research data used came from the Hansard transcripts of the proceedings of the annual ministerial budget debates from the last three years of President Kikwete's second term of presidency. The study demonstrates that the discussions in the parliamentary debates exemplify to some extent the pragma-dialectical stages of critical discussion, and that members of parliament employ various modes of strategic manoeuvring.

How I lost my mother: Care, death and the politics of invisibility

This creative writing study, the candidate's second doctorate, comprises a memoir, *How I lost my mother*, and a reflective essay on the memoir and process of writing. Using techniques of narrative non-fiction, the memoir recounts an emotionally complex relationship between mother and son, and of struggles in negotiating closeness and distance, tenderness, anger and retribution. It discusses issues of care, loss and dying and how vulnerable, poorly paid people (usually women of colour) carry the burden of care. The essay examines ethics, authenticity and subjectivity in relation to life writing. It suggests that personal narratives are most helpful in communicating complex social concerns.

VAN DER MERWE, Schalk Willem (Drama en Teaterstudie)

'n Ondersoek na kinderteater as 'n moontlike tersiêre toneelspelonderrigmeganisme

Hierdie studie het 'n ondersoek behels na die huidige toneelspelopleidingsbenaderings vir tersiêre studente-akteurs in Suid-Afrika. Kwessies rakende die suksesvolle integrasie van verskillende toneelspelopleidingselemente soos bewegingsleer, stemontwikkeling en karakterisering is bevraagteken. Hierdie aspekte is aan die hand van die Stanislavski-sisteem in die vergrote spelstyl en konvensies van kinderteater ondersoek. Kunsgebaseerde navorsing is vir hierdie navorsingsaktiwiteite aangewend en verskillende toetsmodelle vir toneelspelopleiding is gebruik om selfreflektiewe data in te samel. Die eksegese is deur middel van artistieke wyses in die studie aangebind, wat die integrasie tussen narratiewe, nutgeskrewe kinderteater tekste en teorie behels.

Saltwater bodies: From an atlas of loss

The study responds, through photomedia(tions) and live art, to material-affective encounters along the shores of the Atlantic Ocean of the South African West Coast and adjacent islands. Earthly stretches of loss and exchange, these liminal sites are haunted by violent legacies, unchecked environmental exploitation and indifference. As a post-mortem act of mourning and wit(h)nessing the heightened precarity that marks the lives of earth others, the study-as-artwork/artwork-as-study is characterised by slow praxis in times of urgency and acceleration, and a yearning towards more wakeful and just multispecies futures.

Development of value-added dried pomegranate arils and juice powder: Effects of cultivar, harvest maturity and storage duration of whole fruit

The prospects for a competitive South African pomegranate industry may be achieved not only through exportation of whole fruit, but also through agro-processing of value-added shelf-stable products. However, to add value and increase the availability of fruit-based products for consumers, good understanding of the influence of fruit cultivar, maturity status and postharvest storage conditions on a dried product is a necessity. For the first time, the study provides recommendations on preharvest, postharvest and processing conditions for developing nutrient-dense and shelf-stable dried arils and juice powders from pomegranate fruit.

Browning and watercore disorders in Fuji apples explored by means of X-ray computed tomography (CT)

Fuji apples are prone to physiological disorders such as watercore and internal browning. The aim of this study was to explore internal browning and watercore in Fuji apples using X-ray computed tomography. The construction of porosity maps for intact fruit enabled the characterisation of tissue structure before and after disorder development. Internal browning developed in the core region of fruit, and was characterised by low porosity and poor pore connectivity after short-term exposure to high CO₂/low O₂ conditions. Internal browning disorders after long-term storage were associated with cell damage and an increased porosity distribution. This study provided unique insights into Fuji internal browning.

The diversity and epidemiology of Botryosphaeriaceae associated with grapevines and woody hosts surrounding vineyards in South Africa

The diversity and epidemiology of Botryosphaeriaceae grapevine fungal pathogens was explored in this study to better understand the sources of infection in vineyards. It was concluded that woody hosts that commonly surround vineyards serve as sources of pathogen inoculum. These results will help growers to develop new or improved management strategies to counteract these pathogens. In addition, six new Botryosphaeriaceae species were discovered and described and their pathogenicity towards grapevines was assessed through field trials. This study contributes to understanding of the diversity and epidemiology of these important pathogens in South Africa.

Development of a quality-grading system for the honeybush (Cyclopia spp.) tea industry

Honeybush tea, produced from endemic Cyclopia species, has attained a footprint within the global herbal tea sector. Honeybush tea of variable quality reaches the market due to a lack of standardised sensory quality criteria and a scientifically founded quality-grading system. These needs were addressed through the development and validation of a bespoke quality-grading system for industry. Rapid sensory methods were also assessed for their applicability as quality-screening tools within the commercial and research contexts.

Determining the biomass and nutrient content of invasive Acacia mearnsii and Eucalyptus camaldulensis trees in Fynbos riparian zones

This study sought to improve biomass and nutrient modelling of stands of Acacia mearnsii (black wattle) and Eucalyptus camaldulensis (river red gum). Models were developed to predict standing biomass and nutrients, which could be used to assess the biomass of stands of alien invasive trees. Value-added products developed from the biomass were also evaluated and found to have variable impacts on the growth of two common crops in the Western Cape. The study shows new ways to prioritise stands of invasive trees and factors to consider when producing value-added products for agricultural applications.

Distribution and genetic diversity of Pseudocercospora spp. associated with banana Sigatoka diseases in East Africa

Sigatoka leaf diseases are a major constraint to banana production in East Africa, causing yield losses of between 20 and 50%. Pseudocercospora fijiensis, the cause of black Sigatoka, is the most widespread and damaging species. An investigation into its distribution, genetic diversity and population dynamics supported the hypothesis of frequent sexual recombination and habitat expansion. Several banana accessions that were resistant or partially resistant to P. fijiensis were identified for conventional banana breeding. Banana hybrids with low disease development across locations were also identified and will be made available for planting by resource-poor farmers.

Farming with predators: An agro-ecological approach to human–wildlife conflict on Namibian farmlands

Human–wildlife conflict is an increasing worldwide problem threatening the long-term survival of most large African carnivores. This study investigated the conflict between livestock farmers and four major predators of livestock in Namibia, namely the black-backed jackal (*Canis mesomelas*), caracal (*Caracal caracal*), cheetah (*Acynonix jubatus*) and leopard (*Panthera pardus*). The relevant aspects of the predators' behavioural ecology and the agricultural realities provided by farmers were combined in a single probabilistic agro-ecological model. This model was used to design a computer decision support system that managers and farmers can use to mitigate the conflict between predators and livestock farmers.

Landscape characteristics and honeybee colony integrity: A case study of Mwingi, Eastern Kenya

Globally, honeybee populations are in decline due to habitat loss and fragmentation, pests and parasites, and nutritional deficiencies. The monitoring of the interconnected effects of landscape fragmentation, pollen diversity and pest occurrence on honeybee performance is necessary to ensure the conservation of the species and to simultaneously secure the ecosystem services they provide. This study showed that (remotely sensed) landscape fragmentation influenced honeybee colony strength, pollen diversity and parasitic mite occurrence. Higher proportions of woody vegetation resulted in higher colony strength, with honeybees fairing best in moderately degraded landscapes. These results can be used to optimise hive placement for colony strength and hive productivity.

*Genetic studies of *Oreochromis shiranus* towards sustainable aquaculture and biodiversity management in Malawi*

Sustainable utilisation of *Oreochromis shiranus* from the wild and in aquaculture requires the application of genetic data. This study used a sample of 306 fish caught from different locations across the entire distribution range of the species in Malawi to understand their reproductive behaviour, biogeography, genetic variability, population structure, demographic history, genetic effect of broodstock contribution and association of microsatellite loci with live body weight. The results of this study are useful in biodiversity conservation management of the species in the wild and the establishment of genetic improvement programmes in aquaculture.

The relative importance of compositional and functional diversity for ecosystem functioning across different land uses within an arid ecosystem, the Karoo, South Africa

This study determined how variation in land use and rainfall in the Nama Karoo and Succulent Karoo influences the diversity and function of dung beetles. Dung beetles were sensitive to both land use and climate, with species composition in the driest areas a subset of the wettest. Although rollers removed dung faster than tunnellers, soil in which tunnellers had buried dung was associated with better plant growth. This study demonstrates a link between land use, rainfall gradient, dung beetles and the importance of maintaining functionally complete species assemblages for the ecosystem functions they provide.

Dynamics of governance arrangements for small-scale vegetable farmers in Namibia: An analysis of market, state and community institutions

Using a transaction cost economics approach, a vegetable development case study was conducted in north-central Namibia. This study identified and assessed the main transaction costs inhibiting agricultural development because of inefficient systems, combining market, community and state institutions. The results demonstrate that small-scale high-value crop production is characterised by high production and transaction costs that make the vegetable industry less competitive. The study introduces public–private partnerships as a policy instrument linking small-scale farmers to input and output markets through contract production in order to minimise transaction costs among value chain actors.

vir haar visionêre, dapper en innoverende leierskap om rigting aan die hervorming van die hoërondwysstelsel in Suid-Afrika te gee; vir haar intellektuele bydrae in die vorm van beleidsontwikkeling en -advies en vir haar praktiese bydrae om die inwerkingstelling daarvan te lei en te bestuur; vir haar toegewydheid aan uitnemendheid en kern-intellektuele dimensies van hoër onderwys, naamlik kenniskepping en onderrig en leer; en vir haar toewyding aan toegang, billikheid en sosiale geregtigheid.

Gebore in Pietermaritzburg in 1951, speel Nasima Badsha reeds sedert die 1980's 'n onontbeerlike rol in die transformasie van hoër onderwys in Suid-Afrika.

Nadat sy 'n honneurs- BSc-graad aan die Universiteit van Londen en 'n nagraadse onderwysertifikaat in onderwys aan die Universiteit van Leeds behaal het, Keer sy in 1976 na Suid-Afrika terug as dosent, voordat sy tot akademiese ontwikkeling en studentesake toetree by onderskeidelik die universiteite van Kaapstad en Wes-Kaap.

In 1994 word Badsha deur voormalige President Nelson Mandela aangestel om in die Nasionale Kommissie vir Hoër Onderwys (NKHO) te dien. Hier speel sy 'n sleutelrol in die konseptualisering van 'n nuwe hoërondwysbedeling. Sy word in 1997 as adjunk-direkteurgeneraal van die Departement van Onderwys aangestel en help om die Wet op Hoër Onderwys van 1997, die Wet op die Nasionale Finansiële Hulpkema vir Studente en die Standaard- Institusionele Statuut op te stel. Badsha was in beheer van die implementering van die Onderwyswitskrif 3 van 1997 en die Nasionale Plan vir Hoër Onderwys, wat vanaf 2002 tot 2005 tot grootskaalse herstrukturering van die hoërondwyslandskap gelei het.

Sy dien van 2007 tot haar aftrede in 2018 as die hoof-uitvoerende beampete van die Kaapse Hoërondwyskonsortium. Suid-Afrika trek steeds voordeel uit haar kundigheid deur haar betrokkenheid by universiteits- en stigtingsrade.

for her visionary, courageous and innovative leadership in steering the transformation of the higher education system in South Africa; for her intellectual contribution in the form of policy development and advice, and her practical contribution to leading and managing implementation; for her commitment to excellence and the core intellectual dimensions of higher education, namely knowledge creation and teaching and learning; and for her dedication to access, equity and social justice.

Born in Pietermaritzburg in 1951, Nasima Badsha has played a vital role in the transformation of higher education in South Africa since the 1980s.

After she graduated from the University of London with a BSc (Honours) and from the University of Leeds with a Graduate Certificate in Education, she returned to South Africa in 1976 as a lecturer, until moving into academic development and student affairs at the universities of Cape Town and the Western Cape, respectively.

In 1994, President Nelson Mandela appointed Badsha to the National Commission on Higher Education, where she played a key role in conceptualising the new higher education dispensation. Appointed deputy director-general of the Department of Education in 1997, she helped draft the Higher Education Act of 1997, the National Student Financial Aid Scheme Act and the Standard Institutional Statute. Her role in the implementation of Education White Paper 3 and the National Plan for Higher Education led to the large-scale restructuring of higher education from 2002 to 2005.

She became chief executive officer of the Cape Higher Education Consortium in 2007, retiring in 2018. South Africa continues to benefit from her expertise through her involvement in university and foundation councils.

MONALEDI, Ramotjaki Lucky (Applied Mathematics)

Theoretical study of variable viscosity nanofluids flow in microchannels

The high heat generation in several engineering and industrial flow processes may have adverse effects on the user's health as well as the reliability and performance of the product. Recently, the advent of nanofluids ensuing from nanotechnology has yielded innovative thermal management technologies capable of removing high heat flux. This study employed relevant computational techniques to tackle novel mathematical models that unify both single-phase and two-phase nanofluids thermodynamics in microchannels. The impact of various emerging thermophysical parameters on overall flow structure, thermal putrefaction and their inherent irreversibility are discussed quantitatively in order to demonstrate the salient features of practical engineering and industrial applications.

The role of social capital in a trust-building model between the police and communities in the eThekweni Metropolitan Municipality, South Africa

This study used the concept of social capital to examine the of level trust between the police and communities in the eThekweni Metropolitan Municipality, and how it relates to crime levels. The outcome of the study was a proposed social capital model that contributes to bridging the knowledge gap in terms of the improvement of police-community relations. The findings show that traditional leadership is the key component of the social capital model to build trust between the police, the Community Policing Forum and the community.

Transforming in-group and out-group identities in the local Seventh-day Adventist congregation, Cape Town: A realist evaluation study of mission practice

Focusing on a local Seventh-day Adventist congregation, this empirical theological study found that members from other African countries are finding it difficult to integrate into the congregation due to ongoing and increased tensions. Workable solutions were devised in the form of recommendations with the aim of facilitating the transformation of group identities. The outcomes are a better understanding of cultures, greater recognition and embracing among members, and the bridging of a knowledge gap in the academia. A further contribution of this study is the development of a transformation booklet, which will be presented to the congregation and students at a Seventh-day Adventist seminary.

A theological interpretation of violence in relation to Joshua, son of Nun: A paradigm for a Christian conflict prevention in Northern Nigeria

Northern Nigeria is plagued by ethnic/religious violence that has led to the deaths of many people. Realising that scriptures have a strong influence in the perpetuation of this violence, the researcher identified theologies that support violence and those that discourage violence in the Old Testament. Specifically, the study compared the characterisation of Joshua, son of Nun, in Deuteronomist literature and Chronicles. It was found that theology based on Deuteronomy encourages violence and that theology based on Chronicles discourages it. It therefore concluded that the Chronicler's theology is a proper biblical paradigm for conflict prevention. The study proposes a theologically conscious reading of the Bible.

Preaching as homecoming: A practical theological study of proclaiming belonging and identity in the South African Anglican context from 1990 to 2017

In uncertain times, modern society experiences displacement and dissonance, associated with a longing for deeper communal belonging and a reassured sense of identity. As the Church in South Africa seeks to address such contemporary needs, it may offer the Kingdom of God as an alternative lens. This lens explores the processes of reconciliation and transformation within the notion of liminal space as well as consciously acknowledging painful experiences of the past and anticipation of future possibilities. In this study, preaching is described as a communicative event in which imaginal language creates such liminal, and yet sacred, spaces for solidarity and well-being.

HANCOX, Deborah (Practical Theology)

A practical theological exploration of the missional role and contribution of the Christian Development Organisation in Cape Town, South Africa

The missional discourse is the theological conversation about transformation. This conversation, however, appears to be a particularly congregational and academic one, with missing dialogue partners. The Christian Development Organisation (CDO), which carries out considerable global Christian activity in the area of development, appears to be one such missing partner. This study expanded the minimal literature about the CDO from a theological and, particularly, missiological, perspective through the development of a substantive classic grounded theory. The findings will help CDO leaders, congregational leaders and theologians engaging in the missional discourse to better understand the CDO's missional role and contribution.

HARPER, John Paul (New Testament)

Paul and Philo on the politics of the land, Jerusalem and temple

This study shows the political significance of the reappropriated Jewish symbols of land, Jerusalem and temple in two politically engaged Diaspora Jews. Philo remained committed to literal aspects of his faith, individualistic and focused on other-worldly realities. Paul's appropriation was more communal and focused on this-worldly realities. The significance of their respective conceptualisations of authority within local and broader community, in relation to the Roman Empire, was shown through a socio-literary approach to relevant texts of the authors within their particular socio-historical contexts, concluding that for both authors, the symbols overshadow their interest in these as concrete realia.

HAVENGA, Elizabeth Angelique (Praktiese Teologie)

"Om te word wat ons sien en te ontvang wat ons is." 'n Prakties-teologiese studie van die verhouding tussen die nagmaal en menswaardigheid in 'n tyd van rasseskieding

Hierdie studie het 'n prakties-teologiese ondersoek behels na die verhouding tussen die nagmaal en menswaardigheid, waarin die praktyk van die nagmaal in die Nederduitse Gereformeerde Kerk in Suid-Afrika ondersoek is. 'n Teologiese interpretasie van menswaardigheid is as lens ingespan om die uitwerking van uitsluiting op die menswaardigheid van individue – hetsy met die viering van nagmaal, in die kerk, of in die samelewing – duidelik te maak. Ondersoek is ingestel na die wyse waarop 'n verantwoordelike beskouing en gebruik van die nagmaal in die lig van Johannes Calvyn se teologie die menswaardigheid van alle lede van die liggaam van Christus kan herstel en genees.

Diagnosis in the profession of pastoral caregiving: In search of a theological anthropological framework for Christian spiritual assessments in clinical practice

This study investigated the feasibility of the sanctuary model based on descriptions in the books of Exodus and Hebrews as a possible theological anthropological framework for diagnostic and treatment purposes in clinical pastoral practice. The Wilderness tabernacle matched the criteria for qualifying as a prototype sanctuary. It contains all the invariant components representative of all biblical sanctuaries, making it suitable as a model from which to launch the research. The building-sanctuary, as a metaphorical 'body' for God, was analogously linked with similar concepts in the human body-sanctuary in accordance with Paul's sanctuary-related anthropological terms.

'n Teologiese evaluasie van kapelane in die Suid-Afrikaanse Departement van Korrektiewe Dienste as herstellende geregtigheid-missionale leiers

Hierdie studie het 'n ondersoek behels na die kontekstuele en teologiese faktore in die praktyke van kapelane wat bydra tot die rehabilitasie en heling van gevonnisdde oortreders in korrektiewe dienste. Dit het gefokus op kontekste, meganismes en uitkomst om te bepaal hoe kapelane herstellende geregtigheid verstaan en toepas. Van die kapelane benader hulle teenwoordigheid vanuit van 'n sterk kontekstuele teologiese grondslag; ander vind dit meer uitdagend wanneer hulle bestuurders van geestelike sorg en morelesake word. Die navorsing lewer 'n bydrae tot 'n teologiese en metodologiese benadering wat kapelane kan help om vanuit hulle rol en identiteit as missionale of intergeloofsleiers aan multidissiplinêre ondersteuning-programme deel te neem.

LEE, Joo-Hwan (Ecclesiology)

Socialisation of the early church and Roman culture as union and unity: A church-historical enquiry with particular consideration of Constantine, Ambrose and Augustine

Focusing on the development of early Christianity in the Western Roman Empire, this study traced some of the intellectual complexities as negotiated, first by Jewish members of the Jesus movement and subsequently by gentile Christians as they sought to make sense of their religious commitment within the context of a pluralistic Greco-Roman culture. The study concerns the balancing act required by this community between essential Christian values, on the one hand, and the surrounding non-Christian culture, on the other hand, from the point of view of their socialisation. Notable theologians of the era, such as Ambrose of Milan and Augustine of Hippo, were engaged in the analysis.

MBEWE, Penias (Missiology)

Financial and partnership independence: A missiological study of the partnership relationships in the Reformed Church in Zambia, (RCZ) 1966–2016

This study investigated the financial partnership and independence relationship between the Dutch Reformed Church Mission (DRM) of the Orange Free State in South Africa and the emerging Mission Reformed Church in Zambia (RCZ) from 1966 to 2016. The study found that

while DRM financial contributions and personnel played a critical role in building the indigenous church in Zambia, it also undermined the efforts of the local church towards taking full financial responsibility in the period after political independence in Zambia. The study found that the departure of the DRM from Zambia in 1966 enhanced efforts in the RCZ to develop financial institutions and policies that contributed towards taking greater financial responsibility.

MOKOBAKE, Lazarus Majahe (Systematic Theology)

Military activities and the environment? Theological-ethical responses from an Anglican perspective

This study investigated the negative impact of military activities on the natural environment. It analysed various theological and ethical resources from the Anglican tradition, including local and international Anglican theological and ecclesial networks, theological statements of Anglican Church bodies, and the work of important Anglican theologians. The study argues that these resources contribute to a more adequate theological and ethical response by churches to this ecological challenge. It also provides frameworks and parameters for the members and chaplains of the Anglican Church in their engagement with the military with regard to the negative impact of the military on the environment.

UMARU, Kefas Kure (Systematic Theology)

Corruption, human dignity and an ethic of responsibility in Nigeria: A theological-ethical inquiry

Nigeria is plagued by various forms of corruption that threaten the dignity and well-being of its citizens. This study focused on an ethics of responsibility that can help to address the scourge of corruption to safeguard human dignity and ensure planetary well-being. It did so by means of engaging the work of Etienne de Villiers, a prominent South African ethicist. De Villiers's contribution was brought into conversation with the work of other African scholars and the broader tradition of responsibility ethics in order to propose some resources to aid Christians and the Church to work towards a corruption-free Nigeria.

VAN DER WATT, Louis (Systematic Theology)

The reception of the grace formula in Old and New Testament theologies: A hermeneutical and theological study

There is a formula that appears at least 15 times in full or abbreviated form in the Old Testament, namely "Compassionate and merciful is the LORD, patient and full of constant love". Although this 'grace formula' does not appear in its full guise in the New Testament, it nevertheless permeates the New Testament on a covert level. This in-depth study demonstrates convincingly that this specific articulation of God's mercy and grace has not enjoyed adequate reception within theological disciplines, and that, given the fact that this formula is an incorporation of speech about God's activities, it should receive greater prominence.

KENNY, Sinobia (Philosophy of Education)

Exploring the lived experiences and identities of coloured women as professional mathematics educators in higher education

'Coloured', as a marker of race, has not only become normalised in South Africa's democracy, but dominant debates continue to rely on stereotypical depictions of sexualisation, slander and inferiority. Employing critical race theory, this study reflexively explored the identities and lived experiences of seven 'coloured' women as they traversed through an apartheid childhood and schooling to becoming professional mathematics educators in higher education in a post-apartheid society. While the study highlights the professional achievements of these women against debilitating, racist odds, it cautions against the pervading racism that persists in a democracy.

MEMAJ, Eron (Educational Support)

Exploring narratives of community among domestic and international students at a research-intensive American university

Internationalisation of student experience is valued in contemporary higher education contexts. Yet, few studies explore sense of community among university students in unfamiliar university contexts. This qualitative case study drew on social representations theory and Tinto's theory of student retention. It explored in focus groups and researcher journal entries, over a period of nine months, how ten international and ten US first-year students navigated belonging in new campus contexts and the dynamics of community when international and US students interact. The study found that lecturers, discrimination experiences, friendships, acceptance and mattering impacted on student belonging and community building.

MHLANGA, Songile Sylvia (Educational Psychology)

Exploring the interaction between depression and learning in Shona culture: A study of students and lecturers in a higher education institution in Zimbabwe

This mixed methods study explored how Zimbabwean Shona tertiary students understand depression and its interaction with learning. The Beck Depression Inventory II was completed by 367 first-year students. Qualitative interviews with 11 students exhibiting severe symptoms of depression were conducted. Thirteen lecturers who taught participants were interviewed. The findings suggest a 36% prevalence rate of depressive symptoms. Shona students and lecturers understand depression as stress, thinking too much, "kufungisisa", sadness, "kusuruvara", mental instability, and as spiritually determined. Depression severely inhibits optimal academic performance. The study recommends on-campus professional counselling services and preventative programmes to increase mental health literacy in depression.

MUKWACHA, Simbarashe Edgar (Curriculum Studies)

Global citizenship education for Zimbabwean teachers: The case of the Connecting Classrooms Programme

The purpose of the study was to investigate the experiences and views of selected Zimbabwean teachers who participated in the Connecting Classrooms Programme (CCP), a programme underpinned by the philosophy of global citizenship education (GCE). Teachers viewed the CCP as a vehicle for transmitting GCE to learners and found the programme to be influential in shaping their perception of global citizenship education. However, a deeper examination of teachers' perceptions of GCE and their lived experiences of the CCP revealed an uncritical perspective, which did not account for structural conditions that produced social injustices such as neo-colonialism.

OSEI-OWUSU, Benedict (Education Policy Studies)

Democratic citizenship education in Ghana: Implications for teaching and learning in Ashanti schools

This study examined democratic citizenship education (DCE) and influences on teaching and learning in basic education in Ghana. Deliberative DCE can empower Ghanaian citizens to participate freely and equally in different activities in which they can engage themselves, express their ideas by way of argument and justify their reasons. It was found that DCE in Ghanaian basic education is inadequate, as it gives distorted views of participation, deliberation and belonging, and prejudices national development while being remiss of humanism. It is argued that DCE-in-becoming could enable learners and teachers to think autonomously and respect others with whom they co-belong.

SONNEKUS, Wessel Christoffel (Filosofie van die Opvoeding)

'n Ontleding van beleide met betrekking tot skoolhoofde: Die verandering van verantwoordelikhede

Hierdie navorsing het gefokus op beleide wat na die Suid-Afrikaanse skoolhoof se verantwoordelikhede verwys (in die periode tussen 1990 en 2016). 'n Dekonstruktiewe benadering is gebruik om die teenstrydigheid tussen wat voorgeskryf word in beleide en wat skoolhoofde in werklikheid doen uit te wys. Daar is bevind dat die diverse kontekste van skole, die vloeibaarheid van skoolhoofde se verantwoordelikhede en die rigiedheid van die beleide mekaar teenwerk en veroorsaak dat die beleide nie die gewenste uitwerking het nie. 'n Gebrek aan formele kwalifikasies kan hoofde ook kortwiek met betrekking tot die interpretasie en begrip van beleide en veral wetgewing.

STEYN, Shani (Curriculum Studies)

Currere as deracialisation: An autobiographical reflection of a white teacher in multicultural post-apartheid South African classrooms

This study drew on the autobiographical method *currere* to explore the challenges of being a white educator, born, raised and schooled during the apartheid era, and having to reconceptualise her pedagogy in order to meet the needs of post-apartheid culturally inclusive education. Her journey resulted in a new appreciation of her pedagogical self, which emerged in the unfamiliar terrain of a post-1994 classroom. The tensions in the dichotomies of language and culture that came to the surface produced creative spaces within which she could contemplate the complexities of her culturally diverse classroom and ultimately discover new meanings, which have resonances beyond this personal journey.

TYILO, Phelicia Nonzukiso (Educational Psychology)

High school learners' experiences of learning about HIV/AIDS

This qualitative study drew on social learning theory and ecological systems theory to explore Grade 10 learners' experiences of learning about HIV and AIDS in schools and informal contexts. Twenty Grade 10 learners from two schools in the Eastern Cape participated in the study. Classroom observations, focus group discussions and semi-structured interviews were used to gather data. The study found that both formal and informal contexts influenced learners' learning about HIV and AIDS positively and negatively. Collaboration between school, community centres and other stakeholders is encouraged to facilitate high school learners' HIV and AIDS education.

VAN WYK, Jeremy Mark (Curriculum Studies)

Primary school principals' lived experiences of their roles as instructional leaders in selected primary schools

The role of the principal as instructional leader to improve the quality of teaching and learning is currently a pressing issue in South African primary schools. This phenomenological study investigated the lived experiences of principals with regard to their instructional leadership roles in selected primary schools in the Western Cape. The identified contextual factors impacting on principals' instructional leadership roles and on learners' performance in the participating schools were analysed and described. Recommendations are made to address principals' instructional leadership practices and the need for their own professional development and to enhance collaboration with teachers to ensure quality teaching and learning.

BOTHMA, Pieter-Schalk (Private Law)

The significance of trustee independence for the validity and administration of a trust

This study examined the theoretical basis for trustees' duty of independence. It examined two competing propositions – that trustee independence is a requirement for the establishment of a trust, or that it is only a function of a fiduciary duty – and proposes that these propositions are reconcilable. The capacity for trustee independence remains a requirement for the establishment of a trust, but there is also a fiduciary duty on trustees to exercise that capacity. The resultant model, the dual independence model, formed the basis for an examination of other trust phenomena associated with independence, such as shams and abuse of trust.

GREENHALGH, Bradley Paul (Mercantile Law)

Historical and comparative perspectives on trade union regulation, with specific emphasis on the accountability of trade unions to their members

Trade unions are important for the often vulnerable members they represent and, as part of the industrial relations system, for their impact on employers and society. While they have the right to determine their own activities, the study analysed different modes of trade union regulation to ensure alignment of trade union interests and functioning with the expectations of their members and broader society. Based on a historical approach and in comparison with developments in the USA and Great Britain, the study considered the rationale for such regulation, identified lacunae in the current South African approach and makes proposals for reform.

JOOSTE, Jacobus Petrus (Mercantile Law)

Decompilation and copyright in ideas: The protection of non-literal elements of computer software and the idea/expression dichotomy

The misalliance between traditional copyright law principles and acts of infringement, by decompilation of a computer program, was addressed in this study to give effect to the technical reality, national policy and socio-economic and cultural factors that underpin copyright protection. The sui generis classification of software is the basis for reform to provide access to knowledge and the underlying ideas expressed in program code. Through a normative legal analysis, adopting a pro-developmental, Afrocentric perspective, proposed amendments were formulated based on the flexibilities in international law that justify a departure from foreign precedent in favour of a technologically sophisticated, sustainable and contextualised approach.

LOUW, Marianca (Public Law)

Protection of freshwater resources from environmental degradation caused by acid mine drainage: A critical comparative analysis between the South African and German legal frameworks and judicial remedies

A major source of freshwater pollution in South Africa is acid mine drainage caused by the mining industry. The flow of acid mine drainage into South Africa's surface and groundwater systems has devastating consequences that are far-reaching and long-lasting. This study entailed a comprehensive comparative review of the South African and German legal frameworks with an emphasis on environmental, water and mining legislation as well as initiatives that the Southern African Development Community and the European Union have taken to protect freshwater resources. The aim of the study was to identify aspects applicable to a successful water quality protection framework for South Africa.

SONO, Nhlanhla Lucky (Public Law)

Re-evaluating the Constitutional Court's approach to deprivation of property since the FNB decision

This study evaluated the Constitutional Court's approach to adjudicating disputes in terms of section 25(1) of the Constitution, which prohibits the arbitrary deprivation of property. The study found that there are inconsistencies in the manner in which the Court applies the core concepts relating to section 25(1). Furthermore, the study found that the Court's lack of clarity regarding the application of the constitutional interpretative framework and the methodology for resolving property disputes complicates the deprivation inquiry and renders future case law unpredictable. Therefore, the study recommends a particular framework for the adjudication of property disputes that will arguably make the outcome regarding section 25(1) disputes predictable.

VANTONDER, Wiaan (Private Law)

The modernisation of trustees' investment functions in South African law through the implementation of an investment rule based on modern portfolio theory

Changes in investment management and advances in economics and finance have led to extensive reform of trust investment law in New York, the United Kingdom and New Zealand. The centrepiece of this reform is modern portfolio theory (MPT). In contrast, South African trust law has not kept abreast of these important developments. This study's purpose was to examine whether trustees' investment functions in South African law should be modernised through the implementation of an investment rule based on MPT. The study concluded that trustees and beneficiaries can benefit greatly from modernising trustees' investment functions and it offers recommendations for reform.

NURAAAN DAVIDS

Prof Davids is 'n uitnemende opvoedkundige filosoof wat 'n uitgelese posisie onder haar eweknieë beklee. Nie net die suiwer omvangrykheid van haar publikasie-oeuvre nie, maar ook die feit dat haar bydraes van filosofiese substansie en konseptuele nougesetheid getuig, het erkenning daarvoor afgedwing dat haar werk 'n diepsinnige deurbreking van liberaal-kommunitêre denke oor die opvoedkundige filosofie is. Haar aanstelling as genoot van die Sentrum vir Gevorderde Studies in die Gedragwetenskappe aan die Universiteit van Stanford (2020-2021) bevestig haar reputasie as toonaangewende vakkundige op die gebied. Sy het haar ook met hernude ywer en gefokusde aandag aan studente in die diskoers oor universiteitsonderrig en -leer gesitueer – so geslaagd dat studente haar as 'n rasionele, emotiewe en sielvolle onderwyser ag. Ten laaste, as spreekbuis vir sosio-politieke en opvoedkundige geregtigheid, geïnspireer deur die beginsels van deliberatiewe demokrasie en deugdelike waardes, het prof Davids openbare bydraes gelewer wat om welverdiende redes hoog aangeskryf word.

Prof Davids is an outstanding philosopher of education who occupies a distinguished position among her peers. Not only the sheer volume of her oeuvre of publications, but also the fact that her contributions evince philosophical substance and conceptual rigour, has won recognition for her work as a profound rupturing of liberal-communitarian notions of philosophy of education. Her appointment as a fellow of the Centre for Advanced Study in the Behavioural Sciences at Stanford University (2020-2021) endorses her reputation as a leading scholar in the field. She also has situated herself in the discourse of university teaching and learning with renewed vigour and attentiveness to students, who recognise her as a teacher of rationality, emotivism and soul. Lastly, as an advocate for socio-political and educational justice inspired by the tenets of deliberative democracy and virtue, Prof Davids has made public contributions that have gained the much lauded acclaim they deserve.
