

**Bekendstelling van die Universiteit Stellenbosch se HOOP Projek aan alumni,
Port Elizabeth, 2010-10-09: Prof Russel Botman, Rektor en Visekanselier**

Goeie naand, baie welkom.

Thanks for coming – your continued interest in your alma mater means a lot to us.

We are here to talk about Stellenbosch University's HOPE Project. The video we have just seen, provided some background, and I am going to tell you some more in just a moment, but first, allow me to brag a bit.

ALUMNUS-SUKSES

WAT IS DIE HOOP PROJEK NOU EINTLIK?

The HOPE Project is the University's new, ground-breaking advancement campaign – and it is ambitious, comprehensive and integrated.

Die HOOP Projek stel ons in staat om tot diens van die samelewing te wees deur ons kundigheid – die akademie en die wetenskap – aan te wend om ernstige probleme te takel.

Die agtergrond was in die DVD, en julle kan meer uitvind in die HOOP-boekies en koerante wat ons saamgebring het. Wat ek nou wil doen, is om vinnig 'n paar van ons opwindende akademiese inisiatiewe te bespreek.

STELLENBOSCH UNIVERSITY WATER INSTITUTE

As you have no doubt seen in the news, Stellenbosch University scientists have developed a high-tech "tea bag" filter that fits into the neck of a water bottle and delivers clean water as you drink from it.

The inside of the tea bag material is coated with a thin film of biocides encapsulated within minute nanofibres, which kills all disease-causing microbes.

The bag is filled not with tea leaves but with active carbon granules that remove all harmful chemicals.

Each "tea bag" filter can clean one litre of the most polluted water to the point where it is 100% safe to drink.

Once used, the bag is thrown away, and a new one is inserted into the bottle neck.

The “tea bag” filter promises to provide easy access to clean drinking water for vulnerable communities, for instance those living near polluted water streams.

The Stellenbosch University Water Institute is clearly a hope generating initiative.

UKWANDA LANDELIKE KLINIESE SKOOL

Die US se Ukwanda Landelike Kliniese Skool, wat op Worcester opgerig word, skep eweneens hoop.

’n Groot uitdaging in die Suid-Afrikaanse gesondheidsektor is die wanbalans in die verspreiding van dokters tussen landelike en stedelike gebiede.

Om tot oplossings by te dra, het die US besluit om die Ukwanda Landelike Kliniese Skool op die been te bring. Dié skool sal op die kliniese opleiding van studente by landelike hospitale en gesondheidsentrums fokus.

Studente sal steeds deels by ons hoof-opleidingshospitaal in Tygerberg opgelei word, maar sal ook landelike blootstelling kry. Internasionale ervaring duï daarop dat langer blootstelling aan ’n landelike omgewing help om studente nagraads te behou, en hulle motiveer om hulle uiteindelik op die platteland te vestig.

VIRTUAL POSTGRADUATE LEARNING SUPPORT

Virtual Postgraduate Learning Support makes it possible for people with jobs to study further without having to resign or take long leave. This clears many hurdles in the way of higher education.

Our division of Interactive Telematic Services (iTS) runs a modern broadcasting studio and control room in Stellenbosch, from where classes for postgraduate programmes in die faculties of Humanities, Education, Military Science, as well as Economic and Management Sciences, are interactively telecast to 19 centres in South Africa and Namibia. There is a centre right here in PE.

This Virtual Postgraduate Learning Support initiative is very popular and keeps on growing. At the moment, almost 21% of all our postgraduate students study via this platform.

FAKULTEIT INGENIEURSWESE

Hoe werk die HOOP Projek in die praktyk. Hier is ’n voorbeeld:

Saam met die US Raad se R56,5-miljoen saadgeld in Ingenieurswese se HOOP-inisiatiewe, het die Fakulteit reeds die eerste 18 maande R41-miljoen vir dieselfde projekte ingewin.

STANDARD BANK CENTRE FOR AGRIBUSINESS LEADERSHIP AND MENTORSHIP DEVELOPMENT

The following initiative is a good example of how partnerships between companies or private individuals and the University can help to create hope in society.

Drie jong oud-Maties stel 'n uitstekende voorbeeld. Hulle het onlangs 'n beursfonds gestig om minderbevoordeerde studente te help. Dít na aanleiding van hul eie ervaring op kampus, toe hulle finansieel gesukkel het om kop bo water te hou, maar vasgebyt het omdat hulle die belang van opvoeding besef.

Nadat hulle afstudeer het, het elkeen elke maand 'n R100 of wat weggesit, en toe hulle R4 000 gespaar het, het hulle die Universiteit genader en 'n beursfonds vir behoeftige studente gestig. Hulle noem dit die **MAP-beurs**, op grond van die eerste letter van hul vanne – (Nico) **Mans**, (Paul) **Antohnie** en (Alphonso) **Primo**.
