Die doel van hierdie program is om opvoeders vir hoërskool onderwys te lewer.

Vereistes:

- Studente volg hierdie program na voltooiing van 'n toepaslike B-graad soos 'n BA, BSc of BComm, of na 'n toepaslike Honneursgraad.
- Om te kwalifiseer vir aansoek tot NOS moet die B-graad voorgeskrewe modules insluit op minstens tweedejaarsvlak, wat direk aan skoolvakke gekoppel kan word.
- Studente wat kwalifiseer vir twee skoolvakke as onderrigmodules in die NOS het 'n voordeel by aansoek.
- Om te kwalifiseer met slegs een skoolvak as onderrigmodule, moes u die skoolvak as hoofvak (dus op derdejaarsvlak) voltooi het in u voorgraadse studie.

WIL (Werk Geïntegreerde Leer)

Studente neem deel aan:

- Twee weke observasie (by 'n skool van jou keuse) gedurende die eerste twee weke van die skooljaar. Dit is 'n voorvereiste vir registrasie nadat u toegelaat is tot die NOS program.
- Praktiese skoolbesoek tydens die derde skoolkwartaal by spesifieke hoërskole in die Stellenbosch- en Skiereiland area.

Postgraduate Certificate in Education (PGCE)

The aim of this programme is to provide educators for high school teaching.

Requirements:

- Students follow this programme after completing an appropriate Bachelor's degree such as BA, BSc or BComm, or after completing an appropriate Honours degree.
- To qualify for PGCE application the B degree must include prescribed modules up to at least second year level, that are directly related to high school subjects.
- Students who qualify for two school subjects as teaching modules have an advantage at application.
- To qualify with only one school subject as education module you must have passed the subject as major on third year level in your B degree.

WIL (Work Integrated Learning)

Students partake in:

- Two weeks of observation (at a school of your choice) during the first two weeks of the school year. This is a prerequisite for registration if you have been accepted to the program.
- Practical teaching during the third school term at particular secondary schools in the Stellenbosch and Peninsula area.

- Applications close 30 September.
- Two weeks of observation at the beginning of the school year is required before you can register.
