CHPE: Faculty Development Events: Assessment Series

Assessment is central to teaching and learning, and plays a role in both guiding student learning, and in making a judgement about such learning – an activity that has been described as 'high stakes' for students. It could, however, also be regarded 'high stakes' for those responsible for the assessment event as the decisions made about student learning, and their competence for clinical practice, will influence the provision of health care in the future. As the field of health professions education has continued to evolve, so have our understanding of and approaches to assessment.

The SU Assessment Policy indicates that all staff involved in any form of student assessment should equip themselves for the assessment role. To this end, over the course of 2021, the CHPE will be offering **a short series of four extended lunchtime sessions on Assessment**.
