ABRAHAMAS, Yoonus (Medical Physiology)

Effect of an obesogenic diet on the epigenetic profile of livers from Wistar rats and treatment with an aspalathin-rich rooibos extract

Characterising epigenetic changes in the context of obesity, this study shows that DNA hypermethylation of a conserved CpG site in the peroxisome proliferator-activated receptor gamma coactivator 1 alpha (*Pgc1a*) gene is associated with metabolic dysregulation in males. Furthermore, compared to males, female Wistar rats exhibit less metabolic dysregulation, which may be mediated by sex-specific hepatic downregulation of peroxisome proliferator-activated receptor gamma (*Pparγ*) in females. This study provides novel information on sex-specific molecular signatures in the liver, which may underlie sex disparities in metabolic disease and contribute to the development of therapeutic targets.

ABULFATHI, Ahmed Aliyu (Pharmacology)

Drug repurposing and optimisation to improve tuberculosis treatment

The candidate explores the repurposing and optimisation of drugs to improve tuberculosis treatment in children and adults. He demonstrates that the extent of distribution of first-line antituberculosis drugs to sites of disease is drug and site-specific. Drug penetration seems to be better in children than in adults. Rifampicin should be administered under fasting conditions and, for certain indications, at higher doses than the current standard. Para-aminosalicylic acid (PAS) may have bactericidal efficacy. The candidate's population pharmacokinetics model of meropenem allows an integrated pharmacokinetics/pharmacodynamics analysis, linking carbapenem exposure to early bactericidal activity in patients with pulmonary tuberculosis.

Molecular characterisation of proteins involved in iron-sulphur cluster assembly in mycobacteria

Iron-sulphur (Fe-S) clusters are versatile cofactors which are assembled by multiprotein systems *in vivo*. This study aimed to elucidate the process of Fe-S cluster assembly in mycobacteria by investigating protein-protein interactions (PPIs). Affinity purification coupled with mass spectrometry (AP-MS) was employed to identify proteins that interact with the core Fe-S cluster assembly machinery. Several novel interactions were observed, identifying candidates for an alternate scaffold, an Fe-S cluster transfer protein and an iron chaperone. In addition, a bimolecular fluorescence complementation (BiFC) system was developed to analyse pairwise PPIs in mycobacteria. This work is an important first step in mapping the complete Fe-S cluster assembly protein network and characterising these interactions in mycobacteria.

Misuse of codeine in South Africa: a multifaceted study of the nature and extent of the problem

This study aimed to (i) describe the nature and extent of codeine use, misuse and dependence in South Africa, (ii) determine any changes over time, (iii) determine the ability of treatment surveillance systems to reflect codeine misuse or dependence at a population level, and (iv) explore experiences of people who used codeine nonmedically. The candidate adds new knowledge by using a multiplier methodology to generate estimates of codeine misuse prevalence. She highlights the nature and extent of codeine misuse and dependence in a low-to-middle-income country (LMIC), and substantial changes in the treatment population over a ten-year period.

Investigating aberrant DNA methylation patterns in LOXL2 as a potential predictor of diabetes-induced cardiac dysfunction

This study investigates the modulating effect that Afriplex GRT™ and DNA methylation have on serum LOXL2, a cardiac fibrotic marker, in Wistar rats on an obesogenic diet. Results showed that alterations in metabolic parameters are gender-specific, with the type of diet consumed affecting serum LOXL2, independent of DNA methylation, whilst Afriplex GRT™ was unable to reverse diet-induced changes.

Portrait of a pathogen: a characterisation of Mycobacterium tuberculosis and its host, using multidimensional proteomics

This study focuses on the PE/PPE proteins, some of which are unique to pathogenic mycobacteria, located on the cell surface, and expected to interact with the host. They may interfere with macrophage responses, but the underlying mechanisms are elusive. The candidate addresses the systems biology of *Mycobacterium tuberculosis* and host, using proteomics and genomics. In the process, he releases 'omics' analytics tools for broad use, and establishes protocols for advanced proteomics experiments to investigate *M. tuberculosis* genome evolution, how PE/PPE proteins modulate innate immunity, and lung proteome response in TB patients. His findings extend the current genetic and phenotypic understanding of *M. tuberculosis*.

Identification of novel DNA methylation signatures in the development of cardiovascular disease

This study explores the gene expression networks activated during diet-induced cardiovascular disease (CVD). To this end, the first large-scale, cardiac transcriptome profiling of Wistar rats maintained on an HFHS diet was conducted. The results demonstrate the ability of an HFHS diet to induce aberrant DNA methylation associated with a heightened proinflammatory response, which increases the risk of CVD development.

Combining different types of highly parallelised technology datasets for bioinformatic analysis in the context of biomarker discovery for tuberculosis disease and treatment response

The candidate uses statistical learning techniques to determine that biomarkers can potentially replace positron emission computerised tomography (PET-CT) during tuberculosis (TB) treatment monitoring. At the end of treatment, some TB patients are not cured or, even if evaluated as cured, still have inflammatory lesions by PET-CT, making them candidates for recurrent TB. PET-CT is not feasible as a diagnostic tool. The study shows that a combination of RNA sequencing and immunoassay data from peripheral blood can replace PET-CT for identifying those individuals with inflammatory lesions at the end of treatment.

Evaluation of the BCL-2, PI3K, PARP-1 and HSP90 pathways in breast, lung and glial cell lines for identification of candidate genes as therapeutic targets for overcoming radioresistance

The development of new approaches for treating cancer requires the identification of pro-survival signalling pathways, the perturbation of which would render cancer cells more vulnerable to the effects of radiation. In this study, *BAG1*, *MGMT*, *FOXO1* and *DNAA1* are identified as radioresistance-related genes belonging to the phosphoinositide 3-kinase (PI3K), B-cell lymphoma 2 (Bcl-2), heat shock protein 90 (Hsp90) and poly(ADP-ribose) polymerase-1 (PARP-1) pathways that can be targeted with small molecule inhibitors to sensitise lung and glial cancer cells to radiation. Inhibition of *BAG1*, *MGMT*, *FOXO1* and *DNAA1* has the potential of enhancing radiotherapy outcomes in the treatment of radioresistant cancers.

Characterisation of high-fat, high-sugar diet-induced epigenetic changes in skeletal muscle of Wistar rats and metabolic effects of an aspalathin-rich rooibos extract

This study investigates the effects of high-fat, high-sugar (HFHS) feeding and Afriplex-GRT™ treatment on epigenetic changes in female and male Wistar rats. It provides novel information on how molecular differences in skeletal muscle may contribute to sex disparities in response to HFHS feeding, and has important implications for the identification of therapeutic targets.

Exploring the gut microbiome of children from Cape Town communities

The human microbiome plays an important part in human health and disease. There are limited studies of the composition of the microbiota, and of locally relevant factors that influence it, from developing countries, and especially in children. This study focuses on the gastrointestinal microbiota in healthy children from Cape Town. The results suggest that the bacterial and fungal microbiota represent a transitional state between profiles previously described in developed and developing countries. Age-related differences in composition were found, and additional factors influencing the microbiota, such as vitamin A supplementation and cooking fire exposure, warrant additional investigation.

Employing omics to investigate the macrophage response to infection with pathogenic and non-pathogenic mycobacteria

The candidate conducted a global transcriptomic analysis of mouse bone-marrow-derived macrophages infected with pathogenic (*M. tuberculosis* clinical isolates R179, hypo-virulent, hyper-virulent and H37Rv strains) and non-pathogenic (*M. smegmatis* and *M. bovis* BCG) mycobacteria. Data analysis revealed up-regulated interferon and antiviral pathways that related to the killing of *M. smegmatis*. Differentially expressed genes were validated through qPCR. In a cell culture assay, vector-based overexpression of the genes *MX1* and *OAS3* resulted in the increased killing of the pathogenic *M. tuberculosis*, identifying them as targets for the development of host-directed therapies for the treatment of tuberculosis.

The impact of cannabis and methamphetamine use on clinical and functional aspects of outcome in first-episode schizophrenia spectrum disorders: a longitudinal study

Illicit substance use increases the risk of psychosis and is associated with a poor outcome. This series of studies investigated the role of cannabis and methamphetamine, the two most-used substances in our community, on symptom severity, brain structure and cognition during the first two years of treatment in individuals with a first episode of psychosis. Cannabis use was associated with specific brain structural changes and increased risk of relapse, while methamphetamine use was associated with greater cognitive impairments. Interventions targeting substance use in early-phase psychosis may fundamentally modify the outcome of the illness.

Colistin resistance in Gram-negative pathogens in the Western Cape, South Africa

Colistin is a last-resort antibiotic used to treat infections with multidrug-resistant Gram-negative bacteria. This study describes colistin resistance mechanisms in Gram-negative bacteria from clinical specimens, the community and the environment. Judging by the emergence of colistin resistance mechanisms in diverse strains from patients at various Western Cape hospitals, the emergence and expansion of a colistin-resistant multidrug-resistant *Acinetobacter baumannii* clinical strain, the limited gastrointestinal carriage of colistin-resistant Enterobacterales in children from Cape Town communities, and disparate colistin-resistant species and mechanisms in environmental water sources, it is suggested that selective pressure, instead of community transmission, is the main driver of colistin resistance in clinical settings.

As Deputy Dean: Clinical Services and Social Impact of the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences for more than a decade, **Dr Therese Fish** has served Stellenbosch University (SU) with distinction. Her visionary, energetic and innovative leadership helped establish SU as a global leader in the delivery of decentralised clinical training for health professionals. Working closely with senior management of the Western Cape Department of Health and other universities in the province, she played a critical role in negotiating far-reaching governance agreements between these parties. She also served as a member of the medical and dental board of the Health Professions Council of South Africa for ten years. Dr Fish's commitment to advancing social justice has had a transformative impact on both the university and health sector in South Africa.

BASSA, Fatima Cassim (Internal Medicine)

Management of lymphoma in a centre with high HIV and tuberculosis prevalence

The staging and management of patients with lymphoma can be challenging. This is particularly so in environments with high HIV and TB prevalence, such as South Africa, and has not been studied previously. This study evaluates the clinical profiles, management and outcomes of such patients, utilising positron emission tomography (PET/CT) at the Haematology Unit in Tygerberg Hospital. The complexities of patients, both HIV positive and negative, are demonstrated and significant differences found. An important outcome is that PET/CT can be used as a staging tool, and to resolve diagnostic difficulties in HIV-positive patients.

Introduction of fish early in the complementary feeding period to improve infant growth in Samfya district, Luapula province, Zambia

Inadequate nutrition is evidenced by poor growth and development in children below the age of five. This study aimed to determine whether the early introduction of fish would improve linear growth outcomes in infants aged six to seven months during a six-month randomised controlled trial. Results demonstrate fish to be a significant predictor of increased linear growth. Fish powder is proved to be acceptable to mothers and infants amidst a 0% prevalence of fish allergies – a finding of significant public health importance.

Effects of intrauterine alcohol exposure on fetal facial development

The aim of this study was to determine whether facial features can identify fetuses at high risk of fetal alcohol syndrome. Data came from the Safe Passage Study. Three-dimensional ultrasound volumes of the fetal face were obtained at 28–31 weeks gestation, and measurements of facial landmarks were performed. Several measurements show significant changes with increasing prenatal alcohol exposure. The strongest associations are found in measurements of the nose and upper lip, and indicators of midface hypoplasia. Refinements of this approach may allow prenatal identification of fetuses at highest risk, to facilitate interventions in the third trimester and early infancy.

An exploration of the development of community health forums as a strategy to improve communication between biomedical health professionals and an indigenous community: a rural participatory action research study

Using ethnographic participatory action research methods, this study explores and describes the development of community health forums (CHF's) as a strategy to improve communication between biomedical health professionals (BHP's) and an indigenous community (IC). Consensus on the study methodology was gained with participants using four phases. Focus group discussions and in-depth interviews were further conducted with 37 participants to explore the framework for the development of CHF's. Findings show that CHF's offer a bridge for these two constituencies to work together in a respectful manner, despite their paradigmatic differences.

Assessment of point-of-care testing for prediction of aromatase inhibitor-associated side effects in obese postmenopausal breast cancer patients in Africa

Obesity has been identified as the most important risk and predictive factor in postmenopausal breast cancer survivors (BCS's) using aromatase inhibitors (AIs). Cost-effective point-of-care technology has been recommended to predict cardiovascular events in postmenopausal BCS's. Both multiple imputation models and incremental cost-effectiveness ratio analysis reveal that high-sensitivity C-reactive (hs-CRP) and body mass index (BMI) are the predictive markers to be incorporated into point-of-care testing to prevent therapy-associated side effects among BCS's in African settings. There was a strong statistical correlation between BMI, hs-CRP, homocysteine, cholesterol and hypertension at both baseline and study endpoint among obese postmenopausal African women with breast cancer.

An evaluation of the quality of service delivery in private primary care facilities in Nairobi, Kenya

This study evaluates the quality of service delivery in a group of private-sector primary care clinics associated with a tertiary hospital in Nairobi, Kenya. Five studies collected data from patients and general practitioners in the key domains of high-quality primary care. First contact accessibility was found to be good, coordination and continuity of care were average, while comprehensiveness and person-centredness were poor. The findings will assist these clinics to improve service delivery, upskill general practitioners and guide the development of family medicine. The study also adapts the primary care assessment tool for the Kenyan context and showcases methods for evaluating primary care service delivery.

Burden of congenital rubella syndrome and potential impact of rubella vaccine introduction in South Africa

Rubella infection during pregnancy may result in miscarriage, stillbirth, intrauterine growth restriction or congenital rubella syndrome. South Africa is one of the few countries with no public-sector rubella vaccination programme, and the country also has limited information on rubella epidemiology. In this study, the candidate uses advanced epidemiological methods to characterise the epidemiology of rubella and congenital rubella syndrome in South Africa, and assess the potential impact of introducing routine rubella vaccination in the country. The study supports the implementation of a rubella vaccination strategy in South Africa that includes both infant vaccination and vaccination of older individuals.

Combining sexual behavioural survey data, phylogenetics and agent-based models towards a unified framework for HIV prevention research

Sub-Saharan African countries carry a disproportionate burden of HIV infection. Thus, beyond estimation tools that are used to produce HIV epidemic estimates, there is a need for simulation tools to understand the structure and dynamics of sexual networks, and HIV transmission. This can aid the design of effective interventions. In this study, the candidate develops a unified simulation framework that combines, in one model world, the simulation of dynamic sexual networks, HIV transmission and between-host viral evolution. This multi-data generation tool is then used to estimate key HIV epidemic parameters from available real-world data to develop new inference methodologies.

Tuberculosis-associated mortality in South Africa: longitudinal trends and the impact of health system interventions

South Africa has among the world's highest tuberculosis (TB) mortality rates, defined as any death occurring before or during TB treatment. The candidate systematically and comprehensively evaluates TB-associated mortality in adults and children in the context of HIV during, before and after TB treatment. He shows that although overall on-treatment mortality is declining, pre-treatment and post-treatment mortality is high, including in hospital-diagnosed patients who do not link to ongoing care, in those with sudden unexpected death, and in patients after TB treatment completion. The study provides novel insights into TB-associated mortality and proposes additional strategies to improve mortality estimates and reduce TB-associated mortality.

Diagnosis and clinical outcomes of patients with infective endocarditis in a population with a high prevalence of rheumatic heart disease, utilising an endocarditis team approach to minimise blood-culture-negative infective endocarditis and promote valve repair at surgery

Prior data indicated high rates of culture-negative infective endocarditis (IE), delayed surgical access and high mortality in South Africa. In this study, the utilisation of a set protocol for organism detection, with diagnosis and management by an endocarditis team favouring early valve repair surgery, lowered the rate of blood-culture-negative infective endocarditis (BCNIE) by identifying *Bartonella* species, by non-culture techniques, as a common cause of BCNIE. It also confirmed *Staphylococcus aureus* as the commonest cause of IE. The bacteriological profile tracked the presence or absence of a predisposing valve lesion, and a decrease in underlying rheumatic heart disease was observed. Patients who underwent surgery had favourable short-term outcomes.

miRNA signature of healthy vs impaired diabetic mesenchymal stem cells as a biomarker for autologous stem cell therapy

This study combines the complex aspects of diabetology, stem cell biology and single-stranded non-coding miRNA molecules. The therapeutic potential of stem cells in diabetic patients is compromised, limiting their ability to promote the healing of chronic wounds. The candidate hypothesised that impaired stem cells had a unique miRNA signature that could potentially be used as a biomarker to predict whether a specific patient would be a good candidate for autologous stem cell therapy. The study demonstrates sex-dependent differences in the expression of miRNAs and confirms a role for miRNAs in stem cell function.

The role of genetic and environmental factors in the aetiology of oesophageal cancer

Oesophageal cancer on the African continent remains a major public health problem with enormous variation in incidence, geographical distribution and risk factors. No early detection programmes or screening guidelines exist to identify high-risk individuals. To date, the epidemiology and the genetic and environmental basis of oesophageal cancer remain poorly understood. This study elucidates environmental and lifestyle risk factors and their population-attributable fractions across the African oesophageal cancer corridor. She characterises the role of genetic and environmental factors in the development of oesophageal cancer, and investigates the underlying molecular pathobiology, using genome-wide gene expression analysis.

Non-invasive cardiac output monitoring in premature neonates

This study aimed to determine whether bioactance-derived non-invasive cardiac output monitoring could accurately and precisely measure and track, over time, cardiac output in preterm neonates during the transitional period. Although accuracy was reasonable, precision and trending ability were poor compared to transthoracic echocardiography. Numerous physiological, interventional and technological parameters influenced this. However, on an individual level, bioactance may be able to monitor hemodynamic parameters, as parameters showed changes in the same direction as described in transitional physiology. Further research is required before bioactance can be used to replace transthoracic echocardiography at the bedside.

Identity trajectories of health professions educators involved in master's-level health professions education studies

Master's programmes in health professions education aim to meet the global demand for education scholars and leaders. This multiple-case study, situated within an interpretivist paradigm, explores the learning and identity trajectories of education master's candidates. It highlights several factors that may enable or constrain the development of education leaders and scholars in the context of these programmes. These include transitional challenges inherent in master's studies in education, the negotiation of an educator identity across the boundaries of epistemologically and ontologically diverse communities of practice, and the impact of organisational culture on the sustainability of the education scholar and leader identity.

Sy pligte behels die uitreik van akademiese rekords, graaddokumente, kurrikuluminhoud en ander amptelike verklarings aan studente, alumni, beroepsliggame en ander belanghebbendes. Hoewel dit dikwels agter die skerms gebeur, is hierdie pligte van die allergrootste belang vir akademiese instellings se reputasie omdat foute of swak dienslewering tot groot ontevredenheid kan lei en 'n aansienlike risiko vir 'n instelling inhou.

Samuel het in 2006 die gebruik van albei sy bene verloor. Nietemin bly lewer hy konsekwente en lojale diens, en is hy 'n toonbeeld van uitnemendheid ondanks terugslae.

Having joined Stellenbosch University in 1991, **Samuel de Beer** has been involved in the processing and issuing of academic records since 2000.

His functions include issuing academic records, graduation documentation, curriculum contents and other official statements to students, alumni, professional bodies and other stakeholders. Although they often go by unnoticed, these functions are core to the reputation of academic institutions, as errors or poor service delivery can result in great dissatisfaction and pose a significant risk to an institution.

Samuel lost the use of both his legs in 2006. Nevertheless, he maintains a record of consistent and loyal service, exemplifying excelling against the odds.

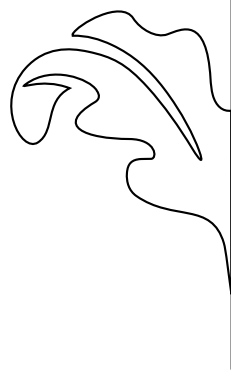

DANIELS, Desiree Margaret (Business Management and Administration)

Scaling the value-creation capacity of non-profit organisations through an evolving partnering portfolio: Learning from a case in practice

This study sought to determine whether a positive causal association exists between the evolution of the interorganisational relations of a non-profit organisation (NPO) and the scale of capacity it enjoys. Established in 1989, Learn to Earn has become a hub NPO. The diversity of partner relations is sufficiently argued to provide empirical evidence for this enquiry. In the study, issues of NPO self-sustainability and the sustainability of the outcomes of its work stand central.

ADDAE-MANU, Richard Kwaku (Development Finance)

Insurance sector development and linkages with the broader financial markets

This study addresses the insurance sector development gap in Africa and other emerging markets. It examines the linkages between insurance penetration and financial market movements, households and insurance consumption, and foreign capital and insurance penetration rates. The documented results suggest that bancassurance and insurance linkages with the bond and stock markets can significantly influence the financial sector. Also, microinsurance product design, a client-focused insurance approach as well as insurance solutions for remittances and foreign direct investment (FDI) can enhance growth in the insurance sector. The higher the insurance consumption and penetration rates, the greater the potential capital flows to support economic growth prospects.

BUTLER, Rika (Accounting)

Smartphone user threat avoidance behaviour in South Africa

Unsafe smartphone user behaviour increases susceptibility to mobile threats. Improved understanding of aspects that motivate safe behaviour will enable the design of suitable interventions to improve mobile security. This study investigates the threat avoidance behaviour of South African smartphone users. Factors that influence users' declarative and procedural knowledge are combined with principles of the Technology Threat Avoidance Theory to develop a model for smartphone users' threat avoidance behaviour. A significant association between avoidance motivation and avoidance behaviour is confirmed. During threat appraisal, users' behaviour is significantly influenced by their threat perception. Users' threat discernment and perceived severity are significant predictors of their perceived threat.

LINKS, Calumet (Economics)

The economic impact on the Khoe on the northeastern frontier of the Cape Colony

The study investigates the role that Khoe labourers played in shaping the northeastern economy of the Cape Colony in the period 1787–1828. As such, it attempts to reaffirm the Khoe's critical part in South African economic history. The research relies on records compiled by the colonial authorities to further their own agenda. This is fitting, since the study effectively uses the tools of the silencer to give a voice to the silenced. The results of the study indicate that, although the Khoe were the backbone of the frontier colonial economy, their systematic disenfranchisement left them destitute.

LUABA, Kampinda (Public and Development Management)

Collaborative natural resource governance for biodiversity and livelihoods around protected areas: a dual case study of Kaingu and Kaindu, Zambia

This study was motivated by the high levels of biodiversity loss and rural poverty in the game management areas around the Kafue National Park in Zambia. Using a mixed-methods approach, the state-centric natural resources governance system and the community-based natural resources management (CBNRM) institutions are assessed and compared to develop a novel model for the governance of wildlife, forests and fisheries. The findings from both cases reveal many challenges relating to community participation, the flow of benefits, and the enforcement of policy regulations. The study culminates in the development of a hybrid model for ensuring positive conservation and socioeconomic outcomes involving state, community, private and civil-society actors.

NEL, Rudie (Business Management and Administration)

The effect of investor-level tax reform on payout policies: evidence from companies listed in selected sectors on the Johannesburg Stock Exchange

Tax reform in South Africa since 2011 offers a unique setting to research whether the payout policies of selected companies listed on the Johannesburg Stock Exchange have been adjusted on the basis of investor-level tax reform. This study demonstrates the increased role of taxes as a result of the conflicting tax preferences of investors (individuals, corporates and institutions) for different payout methods (defined as dividends, capital distributions, additional shares, and share repurchases). Based on changes in tax preferences, corporate investors are found to be the most affected investor type in explaining changes in dividends. The results of this study could inform government, investors and researchers regarding the impact of tax reform on corporate behaviour.

OKOLIKO, Dominic Ayegba (Public and Development Management)

Media(ted) climate change in South Africa, Nigeria and Kenya: Reimagining the public for engagement

Media(ted) climate change focuses on how the public make sense of climate issues. The candidate first problematises ‘the public’ as a category of actors engaged in sense-making around climate. He then traces how the African public engage in such sense-making through a content analysis of six newspapers across South Africa, Nigeria and Kenya. He reviews the literature to describe what a mediascape supportive of inclusive climate coverage would look like, and analyses 315 newspaper articles and 11 interviews with journalists for diversity of actors and plurality of ideas. The study concludes by stressing the importance of publicly engaged communication in climate governance.

ONWU, Ekenedilichukwu (Business Management and Administration)

Drivers of entrepreneurial orientation and innovation capabilities in African internet start-ups

Some 90% of technology-based start-ups collapse within their first year of operation. This study investigates the required capabilities to foster innovation and entrepreneurship in internet start-ups, and how these capabilities directly influence start-up performance. A sample of 254 individuals employed in tech start-ups across four African countries (Nigeria, Ghana, Kenya and South Africa) were surveyed. The results show that top-management capabilities, technological competence, organisational learning capabilities, innovation capabilities and entrepreneurial orientation drive organisational performance. The findings contribute to a better understanding of the combined mediating effects of innovation capabilities and entrepreneurial orientation – previously often studied separately – on fostering firm performance.

OOSTHUIZEN, Marius (Public and Development Management)

The institutional social dialogue: a micro-foundational perspective of the Nedlac of South Africa

Through a micro-foundational perspective of Nedlac, a legislatively mandated forum for social dialogue in South Africa since 1994, this study identifies the limitations of consensus-building due to inadequate management of competing logics and frame formation during interactions between actors in the economic policy discourse. It does so using a multilayer framework against the backdrop of the political economy, and casts institutional entrepreneurship as integrative leadership in the pursuit of consensus-building. The study improves our understanding of institutional leadership in the context of policy deliberation, as part of the institutional life of pluralistic democratic societies. It enhances a micro-foundational perspective of institutions and of policymaking in contexts beset with conflicting interests.

SOTOLA, Olusegun David (Public and Development Management)

Understanding the private and public-sector corruption nexus: evidence from Nigeria

Corruption is globally pervasive, and its negative impact is well documented in literature. However, literature covering the subject is dominated by research on public-sector corruption, while private-sector corruption is generally underresearched and underrepresented. In addition, existing knowledge is fragmented along disciplinary and methodological lines. This study addresses this gap by focusing on private-sector corruption and its links with public-sector corruption. It comprises four standalone but thematically connected articles. Collectively, the four articles argue that corruption between the private and public sectors is largely collusive in nature, and that most acts of corruption take place at the interface of the private and public sectors.

VON HIRSCHBERG, Jeanne Esme (Business Management and Administration)

The impact of leadership and relational quality on product innovation performance in the grocery retail environment

This study aimed to gain insight into the contribution of leadership and relationships in enabling product innovation performance in a frenetic and predominantly transactional grocery retail environment. The leadership aspect explores the degree to which leaders are transformative, and followers employ self-leadership traits. The study examines both internal-team leader-follower relationship quality and external-team retailer-supplier relationship quality. Product innovation performance is measured according to commercial success in the form of end-consumer adoption and relevance. Achieving innovation performance is largely dependent on the knowledge workers responsible for developing the innovation. Therefore, ensuring the appropriate organisational conditions to increase the success rate of innovation remains a 21st-century challenge.

Mr Van Rooyen's dedication, strategic foresight, resourcefulness and strong leadership have had a profound impact on the smooth functioning of the Faculty and the success of our students.

VERANTWOORDELIKHEIDSENTRUM: UITVOERENDE BEDRYFSHOOF RESPONSIBILITY CENTRE: CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER

JAPIE ENGELBRECHT

Japie Engelbrecht, Direkteur: Bepanning en Ontwikkeling, bestuur tans 'n konstruksieportefeuje van meer as R2 miljard, wat die Universiteit Stellenbosch (US) die afgelope paar jaar reeds die grootste ontwikkelaar in die Wes-Kaap maak. Hy het 'n kernbydrae gelewer tot die ontwerp van die projekbestuursmetodologie vir die Kampusvernuwingsprojek, een van die US se omvattendste infrastruktuurprojekte tot nog toe. Onder sy leierskap het die US verskeie hoëprofielprojekte voltooi, waaronder die Jan Mouton Leersentrum en die vinnige heroprigting van die brandbeskadigde Huis ten Bosch. Die Departement van Hoër Onderwys en Opleiding beskryf die US se kapitaalprojekte as "die beste in die sektor", en mnr Engelbrecht verdien erkenning vir sy onmisbare rol in hierdie sukses.

Japie Engelbrecht, Director: Planning and Development, currently manages a construction portfolio worth over R2 billion, which has made Stellenbosch University (SU) the largest developer in the Western Cape for the past several years. He was instrumental in designing the project management methodology for the Campus Renewal Project, one of SU's most significant infrastructure projects to date. Under his leadership, SU completed many high-profile projects, including the Jan Mouton Learning Centre and the rapid rebuild of the fire-damaged Huis ten Bosch. The Department of Higher Education and Training has described SU's capital projects as "the best in the sector", and Mr Engelbrecht deserves recognition for his essential role in this success.

ILHAAM GROENEWALD

Ilhaam Groenewald, Hoofdirekteur: Maties Sport, is 'n leier op die nasionale verhoog, onder meer as lid van die direksie van die Suid-Afrikaanse Sportkonfederasie en Olimpiese Komitee (SASKOK) en voorheen as die eerste vrouedireksielid van die SA Rugbyunie. Sy is 'n voormalige en deesdae erevoorsitter van Universiteitsport Suid-Afrika (USSA). Tog is haar grootste impak dié in haar leiersrol by Maties. Vir me Groenewald is die Universiteit Stellenbosch se atlete "eerstens studente", en danksy haar steunprogram het hoëprestasieatlete se moduleslaagsyfer tot 89% gestyg. Sy gee die toon aan in die transformasie van die Universiteit se sportspanne en -personeel, wat merkwaardige sukses in meer as 30 sportsoorte tot gevolg het.

Ilhaam Groenewald, Chief Director: Maties Sport, leads on the national stage as, among others, member of the South African Sports Confederation and Olympic Committee (SASCOC) board and formerly as the first female SA Rugby Union board member. She is a past and now honorary president of University Sports South Africa (USSA). Her most significant impact, however, is in her leadership role at Maties. To Ms Groenewald, Stellenbosch University's athletes are "students first", and her support programme has seen high-performance athletes' module pass rate climb to 89%. She has led the transformation of the University's sports teams and staff, and tremendous success has followed in more than 30 sport codes..

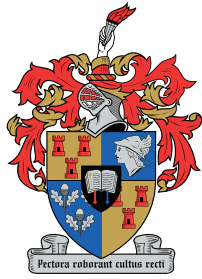
